HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faii stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faii stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was a new manager for the U23s (Development Squad) with Ryan Gayler appointed as Manager and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 sees Jamie Crellin taking over as First Team Manager, with both Danny Lee and Lee Cole (former Academy manager and coach) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager and First Team coach respectively. The U23s have been disbanded but we will have an additional U18s playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays.

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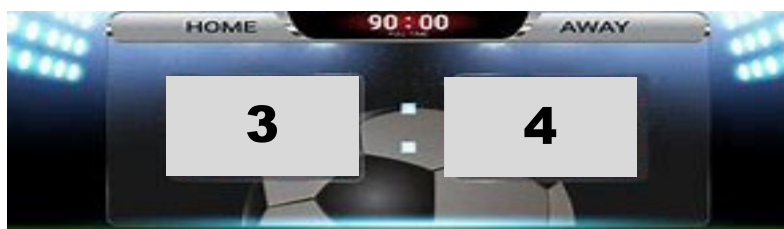

Somehow Bridges managed to turn victory into a defeat against a side who played the whole of the second half without a recognised goalkeeper. VCD weren't a bad side by any means but with only a minute of normal time remaining the home side led 3-2 and then managed to drop not just one but all three points!

VCD had the benefit of a goal with just two minutes on the clock as failure to clear a long throw by the Bridges defence led to a simple header by **JEFF DUAH-KESSIE**. A curling effort by Anthony Adesite was then held by Mitch Bromage, whilst at the other end Dan Perry had a goal ruled out for offside after a nice through ball by Brannon O'Neill.

Bridges drew level finally in the 19th minute when Noel Leighton's through ball invited **DAN PERRY** to lob keeper Sam Mott and it was even better for the home side three minutes later when the influential Leighton produced a lovely cross from the right and **CURTIS GAYLER** timed his run to perfection to score. However, it took VCD just two more minutes to respond with **ANTHONY ADESITE** netting with a wicked swerving shot that dipped into the bottom far corner of Bromage's net.

Mott did well to tip over a Perry header whilst Leighton shot just wide, but shortly before the interval the game was halted to allow a clearly distressed Mott to receive attention for what seemed to be a problem with his ribs. In added time of the first half, he couldn't get anywhere near Gayler's inch perfect cross to the far post, where **BRANNON O'NEILL** applied a simple finish, and Mott took no further part in the game as he was then stretchered off the field.

The referee wisely blew the half time whistle and Ashley Proberts, not a recognised keeper, took over between the sticks but for some reason Bridges failed to test him seriously at all, and it was VCD who showed better glimpses of goal.

With the clock showing 89 minutes, Bridges still looked like gaining another welcome win, but the dangerous **YOUSSEF BAMBA** had other ideas and worked his way into the box to score neatly. To rub salt into Bridges' wounds, two minutes into added time a cross from the right was swept in by substitute **JASON WILLIAMS** to send VCD into delighted celebrations and Bridges to sink to the ground with agonised expressions.

It was a big night for Little Common who returned to their home, The Recreation Ground, for the first time in 4 and a half years. The Green Lane Boys have been ground-sharing with Eastbourne United whilst their usual home made the league requirements. Three Bridges, however, were there to spoil the party.

Little Common started off well playing some tidy football and had two early chances. Firstly, Liam Ward struck the ball from distance with it rising just over the bar, followed by James Miriam-Batchelor striking the post from close-range.

The quick start from Little Common must have done something to wake Three Bridges up who went straight up the other end and Brannon O'Neill came agonisingly close when he smashed one off the post from outside the box. It was a chance that gave Three Bridges the confidence they needed and found the lead two minutes later when, after an advantage played by the referee, **NOEL LEIGHTON** was played through and made no mistake with a tidy finish past Matt Cruttwell.

Three Bridges gained a lot of confidence from the goal and wasted no time in doubling their lead. Leighton broke down the right and crossed in a ball that even Kevin De Bruyne would be proud of, with **DAN PERRY** striking it in beautifully in off the bar. Little Common were determined not to be out of the tie just yet and fired back forcing two good saves out of Mitch Bromage a few minutes apart. Curtis Gayler then came incredibly close to putting Three Bridges out of sight, striking inches wide of the post inside the box.

Little Common came out in the second-half with more intensity and looked to find an avenue back in the game. Just a few minutes in they forced a couple of corners which resulted in a powerful volley from Russell Eldridge hitting the side netting. That was followed by a header from the centre of the box from Miriam-Batchelor which lashed across goal, and went just wide of the far post.

Little Common's efforts were, in the end, in vein, when they were punished for a handball, awarding the visitors with a penalty which **BRANNON O'NEILL** slotted coolly past Cruttwell who dived the wrong way putting Three Bridges out of sight.

The remainder of the half proved to be fairly uneventful. Sam Ellis for the home side, however, came close to a spectacular goal with his long-range effort curling just wide of the far top corner. In the end, Three Bridges had enough to see out the result, proving to have too much firepower for the home side.

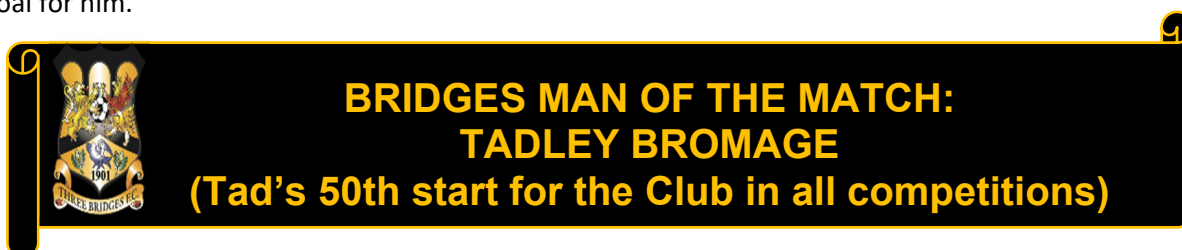

However, a long-range effort nearly caught out Bromage in goal, but the keeper was just able to get to it and the ball fell into the path of Emmett Dunn who headed the ball just wide. Lewis Hyde went close from a corner but his header went over the crossbar. Chichester continued to look dangerous up until the half time whistle and both Overton and Dunn came close but Bromage made a good save to keep out the latter.

Bridges started the second half impressively, Dan Perry with the first chance for the travelling side but he could not find the target with his header. Soon after Bromage was forced into an impressive double save to stop Chichester from doubling their lead.

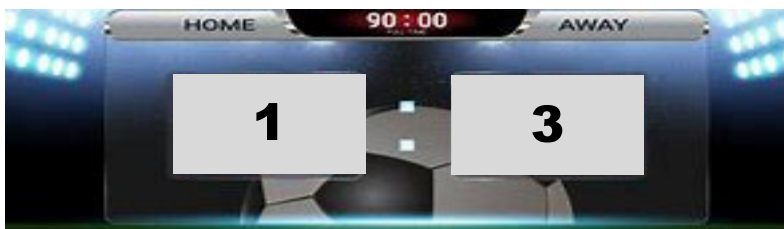

Bridges are through to the semi finals of the Sussex Senior Cup, having played all three games to get there away from home. Tougher tests are yet to come with Worthing, Horsham and the winners of next Tuesday's game between Eastbourne Town and Brighton & Hove Albion the other semi finalists.

In truth this was not a game for the purists and the only notable incident of a turgid first half was the well taken 20th minute goal as **NOEL LEIGHTON** latched onto Dan Perry's through ball to guide home.

Leighton was injured and had to be replaced by Ben Bacon at half time, who had a shot blocked three minutes into the second half following a great run and cross by Giani Ashley, who offered a constant threat on the left.

However, the game came to life after 53 minutes when **DEAN LOVEGROVE**, one of four former Bridges players in YMCA's starting line up, found unexpected space and decided to strike from all of thirty yards. Both sides had no more than half chances after that and there was a half-hearted appeal for a penalty by the hosts when the ball brushed against the excellent James Young's side, but, just as the game was heading into six minutes of added time, a wicked bounce left home keeper Aaron Jeal unable to clear properly, and **DAN PERRY** was rewarded for a persistent display by heading over Jeal to clinch victory and that semi-final place.

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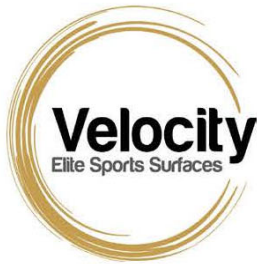

CORINTHIAN FC

Corinthian FC was founded in 1972 by Mr. R.J. Billings (Snr.) to provide football in a safe environment, whilst teaching the players the principles that he believed to be important in sport. The motto was simply “pro omnium beneficio” – for the benefit of all, but on the pitch the principles were simple: “Hard, but fair”. Losing wasn’t considered before the game, but if the result went against us then the players were taught to take it graciously.

For the first ten years of the club’s existence we were pleased to welcome such teams as Tottenham, Charlton and Norwich amongst other league teams as well as county and district representative sides as our opposition. On top of these games there were many regular visitors to Gay Dawn Farm from local clubs making up a fixture list of over 60 games per season.

During the 1980s, with the arrival of an experienced football manager, Mr. Tony Sitford, we progressed from youth football into men’s football playing in the old Southern League. This level of football by a totally amateur club made us unique, but caused problems in the long run in attracting new players. Into the 1990s we dropped back down to the Kent League and enjoyed many a season in this set up.

Early into the new century we reviewed the whole structure of our football club and decided that we had lost our roots in youth football and this was having a detrimental effect on our senior side. So we decided to withdraw temporarily from senior football, whilst we rebuilt the lower levels of the club.

In 2008 we had managed to create a club running 5 sides, from 13 years old through to 18 years old and it became obvious that we needed to consider the next step in our restructuring. For two seasons we had a liaison with Welling United, integrating a senior side within Welling United and developed a reserve side initially playing in Kent Division 2 (season 2008/09) and then moving on (2009/10) into the Suburban League South Division. This partnership has now come to an end.

When the opportunity came for us to re-enter senior football as Corinthian Football Club we did not hesitate to take it. Probably two years too soon, but the challenge was one we were keen to take. We introduced a second senior side playing in the Suburban League to help us progress our U18s into men’s football.

The 2010/11 season saw Corinthian FC running two senior sides one in the Kent Football League Premier Division and one in the Suburban League South Division plus three youth sides – U14s, U15s and U18s in the Kent Youth League.

For the 2011/12 season as well as all the above, Corinthian FC had an U18 side in the Ryman Youth League. We feel that this fills the gap from Kent Youth League to senior football, enabling us to offer a true progression for all our players. The 2012/13, 2014/15, 2015/16, 2017/18, 2018/19 and 2019/20 seasons saw the addition of an U13s and U15s teams playing in the Kent Youth League.

After untimely ends to the 2019/20 and 2020/21 seasons, when the boys were flying high, we are delighted to have retained the main squad, with the addition of some of last season U18s.

Corinthian Football Club are delighted to have been promoted into the Isthmian League Division 1 South East for the 2021/22 season and are looking forward to the challenge, to visiting new grounds and making new friends. We also continue with sides in the Suburban League Premier Division and Isthmian U18 East Division.
