HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faili stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faili stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was a new manager for the U23s (Development Squad) with Ryan Gayler appointed as Manager and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 sees Jamie Crellin taking over as First Team Manager, with both Danny Lee and Lee Cole (former Academy manager and coach) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager and First Team coach respectively. The U23s have been disbanded but we will have an additional U18s playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays.

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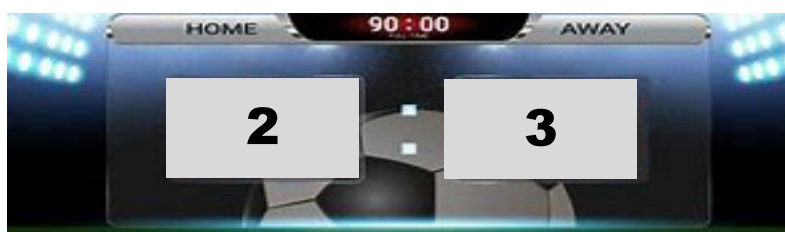
Views from Marina Jack

A fluke goal eventually proved the difference as Herne Bay completed the double over Bridges, but this was a much tighter affair than the 6-0 drubbing Bridges suffered in the away fixture earlier in the season. But for a decision in added time not to award a penalty for what looked to be a blatant handball (even the Assistant Referee thought it should have been given!), Bridges might well have earned the point that they deserved by the final whistle.

Herne Bay were the better side in the first half with **KIERON CAMPBELL** giving them a lead inside five minutes with the help of a deflection. Campbell then proceeded to be a constant threat to the home side, although the lead only lasted four minutes thanks to a surging run down the left by Camron Lawson, who was having his best game yet for the side. His eventual low cross was met at the near post by a delighted **BRYAN VILLAVICENCIO**.

However, again within five minutes, Herne Bay restored their lead when **LAURANCE HARVEY** took advantage from poor marking to head home as a corner found him at the far post. Pat Wanat produced a fine save to deny Bradley Schafer as the visitors threatened to overwhelm Bridges, but injury to James Young proved costly as he was going off and no-one was there to intercept a long kick by goalkeeper **JORDAN JOHN PERRIN**. Wanat was left red faced as the ball bounced and went over his head, but to be fair to the youngster he did not let his head drop and he made a couple more excellent saves.

Bridges responded well with youngsters such as Joe Stone, Callum Chesworth and Ben Aubrey all proving as adept as the more senior players in the side. Tadley Bromage came close twice and Lawson headed just over from Chesworth's cross before Bridges finally grabbed a second with just six minutes of the ninety to play. Chesworth and Aubrey were both involved in the build-up before **ALEX BARBARY**, getting better with every game following a lengthy time out with injury, applied the clinical finish.

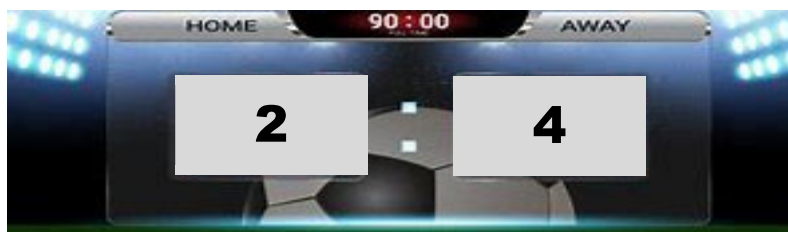
Lawson twice came close to an equaliser and Curtis Gayler was booked for protesting when the referee declined their added time penalty appeal. There was still time for Villacencio to force Perrin into a good tip over the bar, and Bridges were left to rue early errors and a debatable climax to their honourable efforts, Manager Jamie Crellin being "proud of the boys".

A welcome win to end the year. An end to end encounter for much of the time, but Bridges eventually ran out worthy winners with a clutch of quality goals in the process.

A 4th minute corner led to a mix up in the Sevenoaks defence with **DAN PERRY** delightfully accepting the chance to lob the opener, and the home side's cause wasn't helped by early bookings for two former Bridges players in Luke Leppard and Steve Smith.

However, Sevenoaks were level after 13 minutes when a cross from the right was met by a crisp volley by **BOBBY DUNN** that left Mitch Bromage, starting a League game for the first time since his move from Lancing and his injury problems, clutching at thin air as the ball looped over him. It got worse for Bridges seven minutes later when a deep ball found **LOUIS COLLINS** for what can only be described as a poacher's finish at the near post.

Bridges refused to panic however and a good run from deep by Tad Bromage ended with keeper Matthew Blendell blocking Camron Lawson's shot. Lawson was then denied again after a surging run by Alex Barbary, but at last the visitors equalised after 34 minutes when Bryan Villavicencio stabbed the ball through to **DAN PERRY**, who turned and provided a quality finish.

Bridges almost regained the lead early in the second half when Brannon O'Neill's free kick back to Curtis Gayler finished with a cracking shot being blocked, and a cross by Gayler, who looked so much more comfortable in the middle of the field, was just nodded over by Noel Leighton. In between though, the luckless Barbary was carried off with a reoccurrence of his ankle injury.

A free kick from forty yards out on the right of the pitch, just in front of the Bridges dugout, looked to be a case of putting the ball into the danger area, but **CURTIS GAYLER** had other ideas and instead hit a scorcher of a shot that caught everyone napping for Bridges' third in the 62nd minute.

Either side of this goal, both Smith and Leppard, who had received further warnings from the referee, were sensibly withdrawn before a second yellow card came their way, and Sevenoaks seemed out of ideas, although Joe Stone was perhaps fortunate to escape with only a yellow card as he fouled two players in the space of a couple of seconds. Even Bridges Chairman Paul Faili, a big fan of Stone, felt that a red card should have been shown!

Noel Leighton fired just wide as Bridges continued to attack and in the third of six added minutes, Callum Chesworth was brought down a yard inside the penalty area. Incredibly, the referee decided to award a free kick on the edge of the box instead, but it made no difference as **CURTIS GAYLER** hit a gorgeous shot into the far right corner of Blendell's goal to complete a worthy victory.

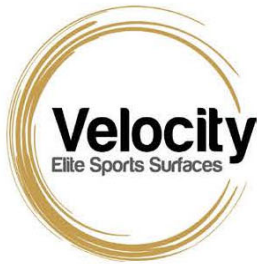

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EAST GRINSTEAD TOWN

East Grinstead Town Football Club was formed on 8 May, 1890, although it was another ten years before they played their first competitive matches as founder members of the Mid Sussex Football League. In those early days the club played in blue and white with the town's coat of arms on the breast pocket. It was some years before they adopted their current colours of amber and black and were nicknamed 'The Wasps,' both of which survive to this day.

They won the Mid Sussex League in 1902 and their first major honour followed seven years later when they shared the Sussex Junior Cup with Arundel. In 1909 they were awarded senior status which they have held ever since apart from two seasons when they were relegated to the intermediate third division of the Sussex County League in 1989. In 1912 Grinstead reached the Sussex Senior Cup final for the only time in their history but lost 4-1 to St. Leonards Amateurs in a ferocious snowstorm.

The Wasps were original members of the Sussex County League when it was founded in 1920, but they struggled to make any impact and after finishing bottom in 1927 they were not re-elected. Rather than returning to the Mid Sussex League, they had four successful seasons in the Brighton League before stepping up to the Southern Amateur League. A fresh challenge reinvigorated the club and they won the Division Three title in 1932 with 15 victories out of 18. Three years later they played on the Test match cricket ground at Trent Bridge in Nottingham when they defeated Nottinghamshire Amateurs 6-0 in the old FA Amateur Cup. Determined to regain their place in the Sussex County League, they were re-elected back in 1937 after winning the Mid Sussex League again and finished 5th in their first season.

In those halcyon days either side of the Second World War, four-figure crowds were the norm at their old ground in West Street, East Grinstead, which they shared with the town's cricketers. The club's record attendance is 2,006 for an FA Amateur Cup tie against Lancing in November 1947. Success eluded Grinstead until 1952 when they won the Baldwin Cup, the forerunner of the Sussex County League Cup. That team is reckoned by many to be the finest the club has ever produced. It was certainly the most entertaining – 42 games that season in league and cup produced 222 goals! Grinstead finished 3rd in 1955, but their fortunes began to decline along with crowd numbers after that. They left West Street in 1959 but it wasn't until 1967 that they finally moved to their current home at East Court after a protracted battle to get the ground, which was prone to waterlogging, fit for football. In the meantime, they had a spell at King Georges Field in the town centre.

The club again finished 3rd in 1973 in the Sussex County League but that was as good as it got for another 30 years although Grinstead did reach their first cup final since 1952 when they lost 4-1 to Haywards Heath in the RUR Cup in 1974 despite taking the lead. During the 1980's the club regularly hosted Crystal Palace and Brighton in charity fixtures watched by crowds of over 2,000. Wasps found themselves in Division Two for the first time in 1979 and even had two seasons in Division Three before regaining senior status. They were promoted back to Division One in 1993 but lasted just two years.

Bob Smith, a former player, led Wasps back to Division One in 2003 and they also won their first trophy for 52 years, beating Three Bridges 4-0 in the final of the RUR Cup. Unfortunately, the club were relegated back to Division Two on the final day of the 2004-05 season and in October 2006 Smith, the longest-serving manager in the club's history, was replaced by another ex-player, Steve Norris.

In his second season, Wasps romped to the Second Division title by a massive 18 points, losing just twice all season. Their winning run of 14 successive league games at the start of the season meant they became the last senior non-league team in the country to drop points.

The club established itself in the top-flight over the next decade and their progress on the field has been matched off it.

Floodlights were installed in 1997 and in 2008 two new stands and a pitch perimeter barrier were erected. In 2014 with East Court already meeting the requirements of the Isthmian Football League after installing additional seating, the club began work on a new dressing room and hospitality area, turnstile block and entrance and a resurfaced car park. More than £225,000 of the cost came from external grant-aid funding.

Simon Funnell's side finished the season in 2nd place, their highest ever County League position, and in May 2014, the club were accepted into the Isthmian League for the first time in our history. In October 2014, Simon was replaced by Tony Beckingham, who returned for a second spell having previously been in charge between February 2010-October 2011. Tony managed to keep the club in the league for a second season despite finishing in 23rd place in the table but left to join Hythe Town in September 2015. Matt Longhurst was appointed manager in October 2015 and consolidated the Wasps at Step 4 for three seasons, despite a big turnover of players.

In December 2019, Matt was replaced by the former Kingstonian and Whyteleafe manager, Leigh Dynan, replaced him. The suspension of the league saved the club from relegation, as they were bottom of the table when Covid-19 forced the curtailment, but Leigh rebuilt the squad and the club began the season with renewed confidence and were 4th when the 2019-20 season was abandoned because of the pandemic. Leigh had to step down at the start of 2021 due to work commitments and former Wasps' striker Tony Reid, who had enjoyed success with Westfield, was appointed in May 2021 but after a disappointing start to the season Reid left the club in November 2021 and Beckingham returned for a third spell as joint-manager alongside Drew Cooney, who has made more than 400 appearances for the club.

During the summer of 2020 the first major overhaul of the pitch since 2003 took place with new drainage and irrigation installed, most of the cost being met by grants. This project was completed in the summer of 2021.



EAST GRINSTEAD TOWN

DREW COONEY: The club's longest serving player, central defender Drew has racked up nearly 400 appearances for the Wasps during three separate spells. He's also played for Three Bridges and Redhill and made his Grinstead debut back in 2002.

GLENN WILSON: Another player with vast experience including a spell with Crawley Town whom he helped win promotion to the Football League. Glenn, who can play at right back or in central defence, has also played for AFC Wimbledon, Rushden & Diamonds, Margate and Enfield Town having started his career in the academy at Crystal Palace. Grinstead are the 35-year-old's 15th club.

DAN SMITH: Goalkeeper who returned to the club in December 2021 for his third spell. Tall, commanding keeper who has also played for Crowborough Athletic.

LIAM MONTAGUE: Former Aldershot full-back who joined the Wasps this summer.

OLIVER BOULDING: A popular player with the Grinstead fans, fullback Ollie recently returned to the Wasps for a second time, having made 65 appearances and scored four goals in his first spell.

TOM SUMMERFIELD: Defender who joined the club in November 2021, having previously played for Horsham and Haywards Heath Town.

RYAN GREEN: Midfielder who signed for the club in November 2021.

CHRISTOPHER BURROW: Young defender, 20, who has broken into the first team this season after impressive performances for the U23s.

MERRICK JAMES-LEWIS: London-born central midfielder who came to the club in November 2021. Merrick was a pro with Southend and Colchester for a decade and the 29-year-old has played for more than 25 non-league clubs since then at all levels of the pyramid. His most recent club was Egham Town.

RICHARD PINGLING: Striker who joined the Wasps in November 2021 and scored his first goal for the club against Sittingbourne. Signed for the club from Croydon FC having started his career in the youth ranks at AFC Wimbledon.

OMAR FOLKES: Omar joined Grinstead in November 2021, having started the season with Isthmian Premier Division side Merstham.

JORDAN HIBBERT: Midfielder, 31, who signed for the club in November 2021. After starting out in Chelsea's academy he played pro for Barnsley and Peterborough before an extensive non-league career with the likes of Kingstonian, Dulwich Hamlet, Metropolitan Police, Thamesmead Town, Dagenham & Redbridge and Boreham Wood.

MILES CORNWELL: Miles is a recent acquisition for the Wasps and has extensive experience at this level following spells with Sittingbourne, Ramsgate and Herne Bay. He has also played for Tunbridge Wells.

HARVEY BURGESS: 17-year-old local youngster who has been promoted to the first-team squad this season after impressing in the club's development teams. Powerful striker with an eye for goal and one to watch.

SEIDOU SANOGO: Goalscoring midfielder who broke into the first team in 2020 before the season was curtailed by the pandemic. Powerful player who offers pace and a goal threat.

FINTAN WALSH: Fintan joined the club in summer 2021 having previously played for Horsham and Aylesbury. Usually operates on the left.

LLOYD FRANCIS: Energetic young midfielder formerly with Eastbourne Borough who has broken into the first-team squad this season. Good on the ball with an eye for a pass.

DEIGO CARMO: Another player to have graduated from the U23s this season. Midfielder, who can operate wide or centrally.

ALEX BATTLE: Striker who has recently joined the club on loan from Crawley Town. The Plymouth-born forward started his career at Home Park and then played for Salisbury and Truro City before joining Crawley in September 2021.

RYAN HUCKLE: Defender or midfielder who joined Wasps in December 2021 after spells with Leatherhead and Hastings United this season. Ryan came through the youth setup at Gillingham, spending time on loan at Ramsgate and Dover Athletic. He then had a spell at Faversham.

HARRY MARK: Goalscoring midfielder who joined the club in November 2021, having started the season with Broadbridge Heath.
