Sittingbourne were our very first opponents as an Isthmian League side back in 2012. The result that day was a single goal victory for the visitors, but since then we've had good and bad results against them.

They currently sit in eighth place in the South East Division table with nineteen points from eleven games, just two fewer than the team they beat 1-0 on Saturday in their home match with VCD Athletic. Their best win so far was a 4-0 home success against Lancing, whilst their only away win so far was a comprehensive 1-4 victory at Corinthian.

We continue to be draw specialists this season, the latest being the 1-1 game away to Whitstable Town ten days ago. The Cup competitions haven't been kind to us or our visitors meanwhile. Our exits at the hands of South Park and Staines Town are still raw, whilst Sittingbourne will still be having nightmares about their 4-0 loss at Littlehampton Town in the FA Cup!

Our Firework Night Spectacular was once again a huge success on Saturday night with club members turning out in huge numbers to assist as we had an unprecedented crowd of 3800! The man who became known as Mr. Fireworks, Paul Terry, who sadly died in August, would have been looking down on events with great pride.

Another long serving member of our club, Alan Ladd, is tonight's Match Ball Sponsor, and we thank him for his support for the last 55 (yes, 55) years! Let's hope we can conjure a win for him tonight.

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HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faili stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faili stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was a new manager for the U23s (Development Squad) with Ryan Gayler appointed as Manager and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 sees Jamie Crellin taking over as First Team Manager, with both Danny Lee and Lee Cole (former Academy manager and coach) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager and First Team coach respectively. The U23s have been disbanded but we will have an additional U18s playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays.

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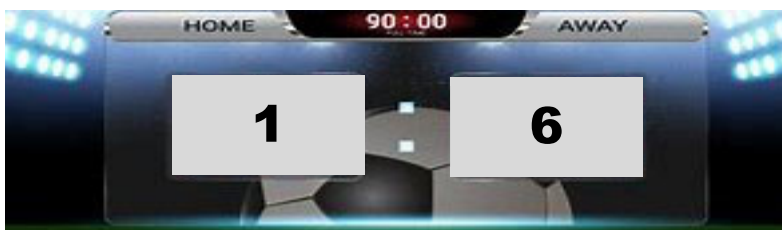
Views from Marina Jack

Haywards Heath showed why they lead the way at the top of the South East Division at present with what turned out to be an emphatic victory.

There was only one goal in it at half time, and the first chance of the game came after four minutes when Curtis Gayler hit an outrageous long range effort that beat Heath keeper Billy Collings but then struck the bar.

To rub salt into the wounds, it was the visitors who stole the lead just a minute later when the ball fell nicely for **Josh Clack** to drive home.

Bridges, who had already effectively lost Dan Ferreira in the warm up, then lost both Ryan Brackpool to injury and Billy Irving to sickness before the half hour was up, but the makeshift defence limited Heath to a couple of shots from outside the box and finished the half with Dan Perry testing Collings.

After the break though it was an altogether different story as Heath took advantage of every minor error, starting with a 51st minute drive by **Davigildo Cravid** when the ball wasn't cleared. There was a clearance off the line from Nathan Cooper's header but a cracking low drive by **Tom Cadman** made it 3-0 after 56 minutes.

Jordy Ndozid hit a fourth after 64 minutes before Bridges' 72nd minute consolation, a superb free kick by **CURTIS GAYLER**.

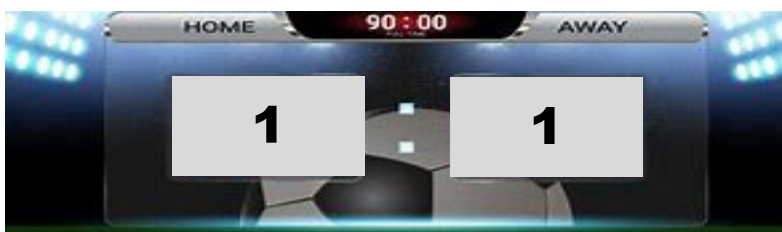
However, there were two more self-inflicted wounds that led to goals in the 84th and 86th minutes. A misplaced return pass by Joe Kay allowed **Jensen Dos Santos** to break clear and the normally reliable Dan Smith allowed a shot from substitute **Sam Remfry** to creep under him to make it an uncomfortable day for Jamie Crellin and his team.

Bridges almost claimed all three points when Michael Wilson thundered a shot against the crossbar with what proved to be the last kick of the game. Possibly they didn't deserve to win but equally they didn't deserve to lose, and certainly they were the more dominant side in the last quarter of the match.

Dan Perry was also denied by the crossbar after just 10 minutes and a minute later Whitstable keeper Dan Eason, celebrating his 250th appearance for the side, held onto Billy Irving's header, but after 16 minutes it was the turn of Leo Anderson to make the first of a number of good saves with a low dive to turn away Jake Mackenzie's shot.

Harry Stannard shot just wide as Whitstable had a purple patch, but generally the Bridges defence marshalled their hosts well. Tadley Bromage was in a particularly belligerent mood as he won most of the battles against the experienced Harry Goodger, although the Town striker was hampered by an early booking that could so easily have been a red card.

Alex Barbary made a welcome return to Bridges following injury in a pre-season friendly, but after an hour he was replaced by Callum Chesworth, who worried and hassled the home defence at every opportunity. His reward came after 78 minutes when he skipped past two defenders on the right just avoiding putting the ball out of play. His subsequent low cross was met at the far post by **DAN PERRY** for what proved to be the equaliser.

Bizarrely, Whitstable had taken the lead just a minute after Chesworth's introduction when a clumsy challenge led to a penalty which gave **Harry Goodger** the chance to gain some redemption for what had been a frustrating losing battle against Bromage and company.

Whitstable though did have a few bright moments from their half time substitute Muhammed Cham, who twice forced Anderson to make excellent saves, but it was Bridges who finished the game stronger and came so close to grabbing all three points when Chesworth cut in this time from the left and set up Wilson for a shot that cannoned down off the crossbar but not over the line.

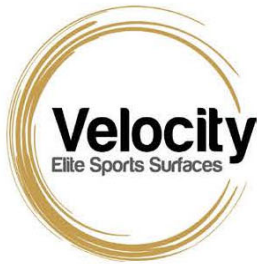

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SITTINGBOURNE FC

The club was started as Sittingbourne United back in 1881. In 1886 it became Sittingbourne Football Club and played at the Bull Ground in the centre of town. 1892 the club gained senior status. The club won its first major title in 1897/98 when it won the Kent League.

The Kent Senior Cup followed in 1902. After the First World War more senior cup and league titles followed with the club also enjoying the first of three spells in the Southern League. Success followed and in another spell in the Southern League Sittingbourne twice in succession missed promotion to the Premier Division only on goal average.

The club reached the first-round proper of the FA Cup in 1962 but lost 3-0 at Hinckley Athletic.

Back in the Kent League Sittingbourne were one of the strongest teams throughout the 1970s and 1980s in an era – unlike the one that followed, when what happened on the field got more attention than what went on off it!

In February 1990, the club decided to sell its town centre Bull Ground (now Sainsbury's supermarket) and buy a 23-acre site on the town's Eurolink estate. A magnificent stadium with a 2,000 seater stand, restaurants, bars, sumptuous dressing rooms, greyhound track and training pitches was the envy of non-league football.

There was success too, on the pitch when, in their first season at Central Park, Sittingbourne won the Winstonlead Kent League without losing a game - the only senior football team throughout Europe to achieve that feat in the 1990/91 season. Promotion to the Beazer Homes Southern League followed with the championship of the Southern Division secured in 1993 followed by promotion to highest level achieved by the club since its foundation in 1891. The ground record was broken five times during that one season with 5,951 spectators watching a friendly with Spurs and more than 3,000 at the match with local rivals Gravesend – a Beazer Homes Southern Division record. More money flowed in with the £21,000 sale of Neil Emblen and Mickey Harle to Millwall before the bubble spectacularly burst. Debts of more than £1 million were revealed, the team got relegated, the ground was closed for a while despite the intervention of the local council in taking it over, and the club was officially wound up. Somehow Sittingbourne have survived it all and even got back to the Southern Premier Division during this traumatic time (in Steve Lovell's first spell as manager), finishing an equal highest ever eighth before the financial problems again began to bite and relegation followed. A new management committee headed by Andy Spice made great strides in tackling the debt problem and getting Sittingbourne Football Club back on an even keel financially. To ensure survival of the club, the decision was made to move out of the imposing main stadium and move to another pitch on the complex.

Because of the FA reorganising the leagues, Sittingbourne faced a brand new challenge playing a number of “unknown” teams in the Ryman Isthmian League for season 2006-2007.

The 2009-10 season, was one of the best since the financial problems, Sittingbourne being in play-off contention for much of the time but failing at the end. Still, a 9th place finish was no disgrace and for the first time in fifty years, Sittingbourne won the Kent Senior Cup in front of 618 at Folkestone Invicta.

For the 2013-2014 season, Sittingbourne decided to leave their home of 10 years and accept an invitation to move to Woodstock Park, a 14-acre area with superb social facilities. Andy Spice, who almost single handedly kept Sittingbourne as a senior club, stood down as Chairman making way for Maurice Dunk, a Director of the company that holds the leasehold for Woodstock Park. After a three year reign as manager, Nick Davis resigned, in February 2018 after the committee decided a budget cut was necessary when it became clear that Sittingbourne would be unlikely to challenge for the play offs. Coach, Aslan Odev took over and after initially taking The Brickies to the play off places failed to maintain this and after a number of losses it was mutually agreed that he would stand aside, paving the way in January 2019, for Dover Athletic Academy development manager, Chris Lynch, to take over.

Darren Blackburn took over for the 2020-21 season and has completely reshaped the team. Due to Covid 19, Darren has not had a chance to make his mark on the club and is hoping the 2021-2022 season will change that



SITTINGBOURNE FC

TAYLOR FISHER (Defender): Joined Sittingbourne for the start of the 2021-22 season. He is the son of Sittingbourne legend, Dave Fisher. Taylor has made the Left back position his own since he joined The Bourne. He has had experience with Lordswood, Whitstable Town, Dartford and Beckenham Town.

SAMUEL OKOYE-AHANEKU (Defender): Former Arsenal schoolboy who signed from Hitchin Town in September 2012. He has also played for Wingate & Finchley. Samuel was on trial at Watford in the summer and did well. However contractual difficulties with another club made it difficult for him to sign for a club at that level.

MARVIN HAMILTON (Midfield): A Sri Lankan international who joined the club from Burgess Hill Town in October 2021. Other clubs he has played for include Whitehawk, Eastbourne Borough, Haringey Borough, Ware, VCD Athletic, Folkestone Invicta. He also made 15 appearances for Gillingham. An experienced central midfielder who has also played in Cyprus and Australia. He scored his first international goal against Nepal on 4th October 2021.

AHMED ABDULLA (Midfield): Joined Sittingbourne at the beginning of the 21-22 season. His previous club was Whitehawk. Ahmed was born in Saudi Arabia but was bought up in Enfield. He joined Arsenal's youth team as when he was 16. He then joined West Ham United at the age of 20 where he signed his first professional contract. He went out on loan to Swindon Town where he made 6 appearances and then onto Dagenham & Redbridge where he made 5 appearances. After that he played for Barnet (29 appearances and 3 goals). The crowd immediately warmed to Ahmed, when he scored a hat trick for the Bourne in his first game for the club.

PRITCHARD ADJEI (Midfield): Joined Sittingbourne in September 2021. Previously played for Colleshill Town in the Northern Premier League Division one Midlands.

TOBY AJALA (Midfield / Forward): Joined Sittingbourne in September 2021. London born, Toby, moved to Dublin and played for Home Farm. His last club was Romford. His senior career began with Ilford in 2008. He had a trial with Doncaster Rovers before joining Hull City. He then played in the Conference for National League side, Hayes & Yeading United. At this time he also had trials with Brentford and Newcastle United. He signed a contract with Bristol City where he made two appearances. He then made 12 loan appearances with AFC Wimbledon. Other clubs he has played for include Torquay United (63 appearances 6 goals), Dover Athletic (16 appearances), Gateshead, Welling United (15 appearances), Dartford, Thamesmead Town, Kingstorian and Ashford United (23 appearances).

MICHAEL AKIN (Forward): Michael joined Sittingbourne after playing in the USA for his university side. His last club in England was Bush Hill Rangers who play in the Hertfordshire Senior County League.

CHRISTOPHE AZIAMALE (Midfield / Forward): Born in Dusseldorf, Germany, Christophe joined us in September 2021. Having then lived in Chester, Christophe has played his football mostly in Wales for CEFN Druids FC, Bangor City and Rhyl FC. His last team was Northern Premier League side Stafford Rangers.

TOBY BANCROFT (Midfield / Forward): Another to join Sittingbourne at the beginning of the 2021-2022 season. Toby's last team was Margate when he was on loan from Gillingham. Toby has also previously played for Ramsgate and Wingate & Finchley.

JOE DOCHERTY (Goalkeeper): Joined Sittingbourne at the beginning of the 2021-22 season. Joe's previous club was Cray Valley. He came through the Bromley academy scheme and has also played for Chipstead.

HARRY BROOKS (Goalkeeper): Signed for us on dual registration from Tunbridge Wells in September 2021 to help out when regular goalkeeper, Joe Docherty, was away. He is now vying for the number one spot with Joe. This is Harry's second spell with us. His first was in the 2018-19 season. He then went on to play for Whitstable (his second spell with them) and Norwegian side, Volga TI. Back to England then he played for Ramsgate before moving abroad again to play for Ytterhogdal, Sweden.

JOHAN CANEY-BRYAN (Forward): Joined Sittingbourne at the beginning of the 2018-2019 season. Immediately made an impact when he scored two goals in a pre-season friendly. Johan was awarded a scholarship at the University of East London whilst being a third-year sport and exercise student following an impressive display playing for The UEL Football Club.

GEORGE CRIMMEN (Defender): Previous club, Sheppey United. This is George's second spell with us, his first being in the 2013-14 season when he joined us from Tonbridge Angels. After he originally left us he joined Ramsgate.

NICK TREADWELL (Midfield): Nick's second spell with us after signing from Ramsgate. Gets through an amazing amount of work in a game. He signed from Ramsgate in August 2012. A player who quickly became a crowd favourite. Before his original spell with Ramsgate he played for Margate. He played for New Zealand side, Southern United from 2017 to 2019 before re-joining Ramsgate. He has also played for Whitstable Town.

TOM LOYNES (Midfield/ Forward): Tom first played for Sittingbourne in the 2012-13 season. In between playing for us he has played at Ramsgate, Whitstable Town and Sheppey United. Since returning to The Brickies he has shown that he has lost none of his skill and enthusiasm.

KANE ROWLAND (Forward): Kane started in the youth set up at Ramsgate before joining Whitstable Town and scored 16 goals whilst with them. He then joined Margate before returning to Whitstable where he scored another 30 goals. The Ward brothers then took Kane to Ramsgate. Kane signed for us in the 2017-18 season. His consistent high quality play, that included him scoring 23 goals for us despite missing quite a few games because of injury, came to the attention of Folkestone Invicta who signed him. Kane re-joined us for the beginning of the curtailed 2019-20 season.

GEORGE MONGER (Midfield): Previously with Dartford, Faversham and Ramsgate. George signed for The Brickies towards the end of the 2020-21 season.

HARRISON PONT (Midfield): Started with Dover Athletic academy and whilst playing for them he joined us on dual transfer for his first spell at the club. Has also played for Hollands & Blair and Margate.

EMMANUEL DASHO (Defender): Very quick defender who likes to go forward. Emmanuel signed from Sevenoaks Town having previously played for Glebe, Walthamstow and Witham Town.

JAMES HAWKINS (Forward): Signed for Sittingbourne after a successful trial. Unfortunately he was injured playing against Sheppey United in a pre-season friendly. However he did enough to show what a good player he is. He made his league debut as a substitute in October in a 3-2 victory over Whitstable Town. His previous club was Erith & Belvedere.

SAM FLISHER (Defender): Sam made his debut in the summer of 2020. His previous club was Bearsted. He has also played for Hollands & Blair.
