HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faili stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faili stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was a new manager for the U23s (Development Squad) with Ryan Gayler appointed as Manager and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 sees Jamie Crellin taking over as First Team Manager, with both Danny Lee and Lee Cole (former Academy manager and coach) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager and First Team coach respectively. The U23s have been disbanded but we will have an additional U18s playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays.

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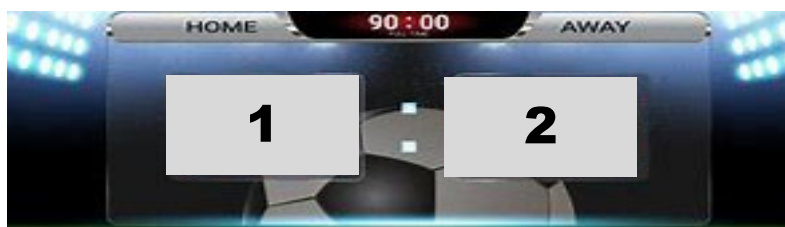
Views from Marina Jack

Local bragging rights went to East Grinstead in a game where chances were created by both sides but often lacked a solid finish. In the end, a needless penalty proved the difference for the visitors as they battle to get out of the bottom two.

An early free kick by Curtis Gayler led to Tad Bromage coming close with a header, but chances were then spurned by Noel Leighton, Camron Lawson and Gayler at one end and Miles Cornwell and Alex Battle at the other.

However, the second half started explosively with **ANDREW BRIGGS** striking from the edge of the box on 46 minutes to give Wasps the lead. Bridges responded with **CAMRON LAWSON** firing over twice from good positions before he latched on to Leighton's perfect pass in the 55th minute to draw Bridges level.

Mitch Bromage produced a good save to prevent Omar Folkes from scoring against one of his former clubs, whilst Leighton came close with a header from Bryan Villavicencio's cross.

After 70 minutes, a clumsy challenge by Villavicencio left the excellent referee no option but to award a spot kick, which **ALEX BATTLE** despatched coolly.

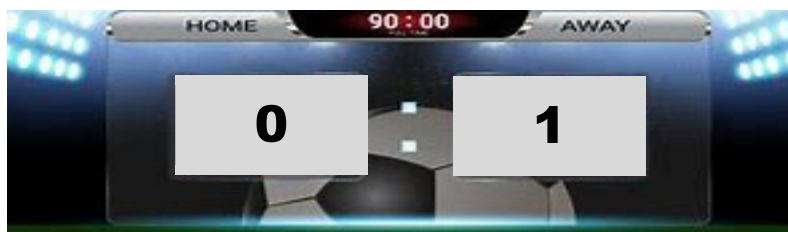
Leighton rattled the crossbar and Dan Perry fired just wide as Bridges strived for an equaliser, although with so many forwards on the pitch by this time, they were always exposed to a quick break, and substitute Seidou Sanogo had a good opportunity to seal the victory, but it didn't matter in the end, and Grinstead's reputation as something of a bogey side to Bridges continued.

After a relatively quiet first half, this game exploded in the 63rd minute when a foul by Jamie Splatt on Bryan Villavicencio ended in a mass brawl which saw Splatt, Joe Stone and Noel Leighton all shown red cards after the referee consulted his two assistants.

Alex Laing, playing against one of his many former clubs, drove over for Whitehawk early on and looked their most dangerous player in the first twenty minutes. It needed a great challenge by Stone as a low cross by Splatt came in, but Bridges responded with Curtis Gayler's free kick being met by Leighton, whose header was just wide.

After 20 minutes a poor ball by home keeper Nathan Stroomberg-Clarke gave **NOEL LEIGHTON** the perfect opening to score what somehow proved to be the only goal of the game!

Mitch Bromage tipped over a good effort from Splatt and Tegan Freeman was wide from the resulting corner, but Hawks, with Laing leading the way, left the field at half time complaining that they should have had a penalty.

A cross by Gayler saw Dan Perry come close at the near post before Leighton headed wide, and after 56 minutes Callum Chesworth broke away only to see his shot cannon off the crossbar. The sendings off gave Whitehawk momentary optimism and Bromage had to make a good block to deny Leon Redwood.

Gayler had a free kick just about parried by Stroomberg-Clarke, but it was Bridges defence who earned most of the plaudits by now. Both Ryan Brackpool and James Young were immense in the heart of the back line, whilst Bromage made a string of excellent saves.

Another silly sending off for Alex Malins meant both sides only had nine men, but it got even worse for the visitors when Villavicencio also received a red card as he lost his footing and caught Redwood on the half way line.

Bromage made two more great saves to deny Henry Muggeridge, who also hit the bar, and Mohammed Kamara, but with virtually the last kick of the game Gayler wasted a chance to double the score when he blazed over the bar from thirty yards after the keeper was caught out of his goal!

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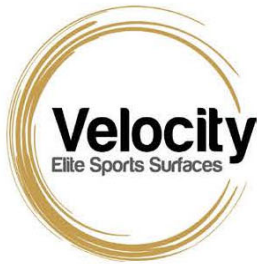

VCD ATHLETIC

VCD Athletic FC is one of only a few clubs to have originated during the Great War when, in 1916 it was formed by workers employed at the Vickers armaments factory in Crayford. The Company originally played only inter-departmental games until it was decided that the best players from the various sections would be elected to represent the firm. The club have played at the firm's sports ground, Oakwood, in Old Road, Crayford, from the outset right up to the present time, except for eight seasons spent ground sharing whilst trying to get permission for the erection of floodlights.

In the early days, only friendly matches were played as there were no official competitions during the war years, and records show that a club called Vickers (Erith) joined the re-formed Kent League in 1919, changing their name to Vickers (Crayford) a year later. In their first season in the Kent League they visited Maidstone United on Boxing Day and played in front of a crowd of 13,500. The Vickers team that day contained seven Arsenal players who were finishing off their war service. Two years later, Vickers joined the Dartford & District League, followed by entry into the newly formed Kent Amateur League, Division One in 1923. Their first trophies came in 1927 when they won the Kent FA Junior Cup and the Kent Benevolent Cup.

It was a further 25 years before more silverware came their way, when they won the Kent Division One title in 1953. The Kent Amateur Cup was won in 1962 and in 1964 but the following season saw a spectacular slump and relegation, with a record of P24 W0 D2 L22, goals for 25, goals against 199.

Promotion was gained in 1969, but after a mediocre period during the 1970s, they were relegated in 1980 back to Division Two. A season later they were promoted back to Division One and in 1985 won the championship, gaining promotion to the restructured Premier Division. By now the Kent Amateur League had changed its name to the Kent County League and the club enjoyed further success when they won the Kent FA Intermediate Shield in 1988. In the same year the club was involved in the last ever match played at Maidstone United's London Road ground when they won the West Kent Challenge Cup.

In 1993, Martin Ford joined the club as manager and, in season 1995/1996 a unique cup treble was achieved with wins in the Kent Intermediate Shield, Kent County League Cup, and the Erith Hospitals Cup. Season 1996/1997 then saw the club win the Kent County Premier Division title for the first time in their history, and by a record 15 points. Senior status was awarded that same year and a successful application was made to join the Winstonlead Kent League where, in their first season in modern times, VCD Athletic finished in a creditable ninth place. The following season saw the club begin a ground-share with Thamesmead Town, finishing up in seventh place but also reaching the final of the Kent League Cup, where they lost 1-0 to Deal Town in a closely fought match. Deal at this time were assembling the side that was later to win the FA Vase at Wembley.

A season later the club went one better, beating Faversham Town 4-0 in the final to bring the club a first ever senior trophy, and the season after that the club made its third consecutive cup final appearance when they reached the final of the Kent Senior Trophy. However, they narrowly missed out on more silverware when they went down 10-9 on penalties to Whitstable Town. The club eventually spent five seasons as tenants of Thamesmead Town before Lordswood FC kindly took their place for two seasons. Then the club embarked on a one year term with near neighbours Greenwich Borough, and despite the handicap of having to ground-share, VCD were consistently one of the league's strongest members during their time in the league.

The club reached the final of the League Cup in 2002/2003, but on the day there was no celebration as VCD were comfortably beaten 2-0 by Cray Wanderers. The following season was a disappointment as far as the cups were concerned, but a creditable third place was achieved in the league. Further cup success followed however when, in season 2005/2006 the club reached the final of the Kent Senior Trophy for the second time. Having suffered a loss in the first final on penalties, there was a reversal of fortune this time when, after having drawn 1-1 with Tunbridge Wells at the end of extra time, the VCD players held their nerve to win the penalty shoot-out 3-1.

During 2005 the long awaited news the club wanted to hear finally arrived when planning permission for floodlights and the development of the Oakwood ground was granted by Bexley Council. This, together with a substantial grant from the Football Stadia Improvement Fund, part of the Football Foundation, enabled work to commence early in 2006. The pitch was levelled, rotated 90 degrees and re-laid. New perimeter paths were laid, along with perimeter fencing to enclose the pitch. Floodlights were erected in June 2006, at the same time that work on enhancing the changing rooms also began. The spectator stand was re-sited and extended, and further additions included a new raised hospitality area situated to overlook the pitch, and a new tea bar adjacent to the popular members bar.

At the end of the 2007 season Martin Ford resigned as manager, and the club are grateful for his vision and enthusiasm over the years that took VCD from being a Kent County League side to one that was always around the top of the table in the Kent League, and on his departure the club had just reached the last 16 of the prestigious FA Vase for the second consecutive season. Head coach Dean Frost took over as caretaker manager, and under his guidance the club obtained runners up spot in the league, narrowly missing out to Whitstable Town, and then the following season Paul Foley was appointed manager of the first team, with Dean Frost reverting to his former position of head coach. Under their stewardship the club finished runners up once more. A year later, the club finally won the Kent League Premier Division title together with the Kent Senior Trophy, culminating in the long awaited promotion to the Ryman Football League.

The first season was a success with an 8th place finish, but the club were left stunned when the Ryman League deemed ground issues warranted demotion, and despite an appeal to the Football Association, the decision was upheld and the club went back to the Kent League. Manager Paul Foley resigned to join Chatham Town, taking virtually the whole team with him, and the club appointed former reserve team manager Ricky Bennett his replacement. Under his leadership VCD achieved third place in his first season, and the season after the team was also challenging for honours and, but for a disappointing end to the campaign we certainly would have given Herne Bay a closer run to their title. Once again third place was attained but this time we had the added bonus of winning the Kent League Cup, beating Corinthian 2-0 in the final. We also lifted a second trophy with a 3-2 victory over league champions Herne Bay in the Kent League Challenge Shield which gave the club a pre-season boost.

Midway through season 2012/2013 Ricky Bennett left the club due to outside pressures, and in his place the club secured the services of Tony Russell, previously manager of Erith Town FC, who joined with his assistant Ray Powell. With most of the players leaving with the previous manager the club was in disarray, but a side was quickly formed by the new management, and a magnificent record breaking run of 17 victories and 2 draws in the last 19 league fixtures enabled the club to once more gain promotion to the Ryman Football League Division 1 North. Starting as favourites for relegation, the club had a stunning run, winning the first 15 games and heading the table for all but a couple of weeks throughout the campaign, and on the last day of the season, sitting in 2nd place the Vickers defeated Romford FC 6-0 while leaders Witham Town could only draw their last game which saw us secure the title by a point, taking the club to the Premier Division, its highest ever level in the pyramid. The club struggled for a lot of the season, spending most of the time in the relegation places but winning the last 6 games saw us climb to safety, finally finishing in 18th position to maintain our place in the division.

Manager Tony Russell immediately resigned, taking the entire side with him, but the club acted quickly to secure the services of Keith McMahon as new First Team Manager. Keith came with a wealth of experience having taken neighbours Thamesmead Town from the Kent League to the Ryman League Premier Division but, with no players at the club and only a few weeks to the start of the 2015/2016 season Keith was up against it from the beginning and though bringing in some excellent players and with some good performances we were unable to find the consistency needed in the Premier Division and were relegated back to Division 1 (North).

More inconsistency during the following seasons saw us finish around the mid-table positions before we were placed in the reconstructed South East Division where we finished just shy of the play-off positions. With last season cut short due to the Covid 19 situation, we again looked to be finishing around mid-table.

It was then decided that changes needed to be made and Keith left the club to be replaced at the start of the 2020-2021 season by former VCD player Nick Davis. Nick had previously managed Sittingbourne and Ramsgate but, having assembled a strong squad, the continuation of the pandemic thwarted the completion of fixtures once more when we were placed second in the table. Now, as we try again, and having signed some new additions to the squad, we look forward to a successful season.

MANAGEMENT TEAM

NICK DAVIS – MANAGER: A former VCD favourite as a player, Nick re-joined the club last year after furthering his career in the game with spells at Maidstone United and Tonbridge Angels. Has managerial experience with Sittingbourne and Ramsgate and knows the Isthmian League well. Well respected at Oakwood he brings that knowledge to the Vickers as we begin a new chapter.

JASON POWELL – ASSISTANT MANAGER: Comes with a wealth of experience from a playing career that includes the Vickers, and among others, Thamesmead Town, Erith Town, Greenwich Borough and Phoenix Sports. Currently Manager of the VCD Vets side, and has now taken up the post of Assistant to Nick Davis with the First Team.

DEL OLDFIELD – HEAD COACH: Joined the club coaching staff this season and brings a wealth of experience with him. Had a playing career at a high level and has also had managerial experience at Erith & Belvedere and Phoenix Sports. Looking to bring new ideas to the club and should prove a good acquisition.

ASHLEY PROBETS – PLAYER/COACH: Began his career at Arsenal where he signed professional forms as a youngster before moving on to Rochdale where he also played as a professional. Has a cultured left foot and good tactical awareness, also bringing calmness to our defence where he is great influence on our younger players. Played for the Vickers early in his non-league career before having spells with Crawley Town, Welling United, Thamesmead Town and Phoenix Sports.

DAMIEN HOPKINS – GOALKEEPING COACH: Had a playing career with Chatham Town and Lordswood before injury curtailed his on-field progress. Took the option of qualifying as a coach, gaining experience with Hollands & Blair, Sittingbourne and Hythe Tow before coming to Oakwood. Good around the players and well respected in the dressing room, proving a good acquisition for the club.

LAUREN CLEMENT – PHYSIO: A new addition to the Management Team who comes with a BSC in Sport & Exercise Rehabilitation from Middlesex University. Will be looking to minimise the absence of players through injury in our objective of putting out our strongest of teams at all times. Greatly experienced with time spent at Hendon, Edgware Town, Erith & Belvedere and Thurrock RFC.

SAM MOTT – GOALKEEPER: Highly experienced goalkeeper who joined the club at the start of this season. Has a commanding presence and is good in the air and gives great vocal support to our defenders. A good shot stopper who kicks well and will prove a good asset to the club. Previous experience with Thamesmead Town, Hornchurch, Ashford United and Welling United.

THEODORE MCKENZIE – DEFENDER: Made the step up from our U18 side and put in some impressive performances. A solid defender with great pace and technical ability who likes to get forward, but is always mindful of his defensive responsibilities. Has not looked out of place at this level and should become an integral part of our squad. It is up to him how far he wants to progress in the game.

CHRIS EDWARDS – DEFENDER: A new addition to the squad who signed last season and brings experience and composure to our back line. Has pace getting forward and looks to support our attacking play whilst aware of defensive responsibilities. Has slotted in well and looks to be a good acquisition to the club. Previous experience with Thamesmead Town, Glebe, Sheppey United and Sevenoaks Town.

MOHAMMED OSHILAJA – DEFENDER: Joined the Vickers at the start of last season and made an immediate impression with his pace and composure in defence. Good under pressure and with great aerial ability he will be a valuable asset at the heart of our defence. Previous experience with Dulwich Hamlet, Carshalton Athletic and Beckenham Town.

JACK BARRY – DEFENDER: An experienced defender who joined us at the beginning of last season. Organises the back line well with good leadership skills and is a good acquisition for the club. Also has previous experience with Thamesmead Town.

BEN GORHAM – DEFENDER: Re-joined the Vickers this season from Ashford United where he captained the side. Had a long period away from the club having initially come through our youth ranks, but now makes a welcome return. A tall commanding defender who is dominant in the air, a strong tackler and good organiser, and will be a good acquisition. Also has an eye for goal at set pieces. After earlier leaving the club he spent time with Sittingbourne, Herne Bay and Ashford United.

JAMIE WATSON – DEFENDER: Signed from Bromley and looks to be a good acquisition for the squad. A tall strong defender/midfielder who has great composure on the ball. Reads the game well and looks comfortable in possession. Strong in the tackle and good in the air and will be looking to cement a regular place in the side.

LEA DAWSON – MIDFIELD: A member of the Vickers side when we won promotion from the Ryman League Northern Division before leaving to join Cray Wanderers for another promotion. An experienced player who marshals our midfield well giving good protection to the defence. Strong in the tackle and a good passer of the ball who gives us a presence in the centre of midfield. Has previous experience with Ashford United and Horsham from where he joined us.

AYMAN ELMOGHARBEL – MIDFIELD: A player with great stamina who never gives up a lost cause. Has pace, is technically good with an eye for goal, and links well with his colleagues. On the radar of a number of clubs but has shown his loyalty to the Vickers and is showing excellent development as he gains experience. Never gives opponents time to settle and is a valuable member of the squad.
