HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faili stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faili stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was a new manager for the U23s (Development Squad) with Ryan Gayler appointed as Manager and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 sees Jamie Crellin taking over as First Team Manager, with both Danny Lee and Lee Cole (former Academy manager and coach) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager and First Team coach respectively. The U23s have been disbanded but we will have an additional U18s playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays.

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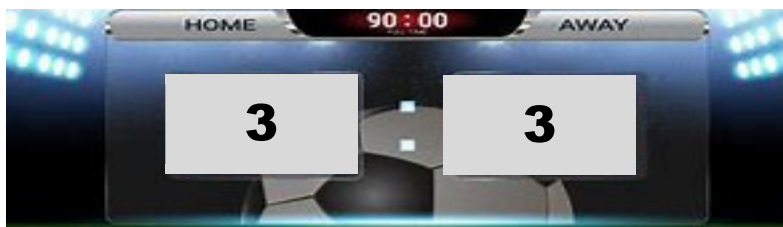

Bridges certainly cannot be accused of a lack of goals at the moment as they have netted eleven in their last three games, but a slightly more worrying development has seen them also conceded eight in the same period. This performance against Hythe was particularly disappointing after the previous week's dominant display against high flying Ashford.

It started brightly enough for Bridges with a goal after 11 minutes. Charlie Lambert and Dan Perry were both involved before **BRANNON O'NEILL** netted at the far post to celebrate his 100th start for the side. However, the lead lasted only two minutes as a route one ball encouraged **TYLER STERLING** to surge forward to suddenly find himself with only Mitch Bromage to beat.

Henry Newcombe saved well from Lambert whilst Mitch Bromage made a good save at the other end to deny Riley Alford, but after 30 minutes Bridges deservedly regained their lead albeit with a touch of fortune. Lambert's shot struck **DAN PERRY**, but the in-form striker was quickest to react to the loose ball and he drove home with aplomb.

Hythe though looked more in control after the break and both Liam Smith and Alexander Brown were denied by Mitch Bromage, whilst Alford missed horribly at the far post after a great cross by Luca Woodhouse. Bromage then held a good hit by Sterling, but Hythe were rewarded after 70 minutes when a deep free kick, a controversial award as far as the home supporters were concerned, by Smith was nodded back into the danger zone and headed in eventually by **GEORGE CRIMMEN**.

Crimmen almost scored again but Bryan Villavicencio cleared off the line after 82 minutes, but a minute later a clearance fell to **TYLER STERLING**, who audaciously chipped over Bromage, who had strayed off his line and back pedalled to no effect.

Bridges made a late change with 5 minutes of normal time remaining and were rewarded after 89 minutes. Curtis Gayler saw his fine effort blocked on the line, but O'Neill was quickest to react and he created the chance for substitute **BEN BACON** to salvage a point.

The goals continue to flow in Bridges' games, although unfortunately they go in at both ends but at least the side managed to grind out a hard earned victory with a couple of excellent goals to keep their fans happy!

An early booking for the home side's Sinn Christie gave **CURTIS GAYLER**, starting his 50th League game for Bridges, the opportunity to open the scoring after 11 minutes with one of his fierce trademark free kicks, the ball swerving horribly to catch out keeper Billy Collings. Haywards Heath stepped up the pace and Jerson Dos Santos forced Mitch Bromage to a good low save, but despite Heath's dominance in possession terms, they rarely managed to test Bridges' defence. After 30 minutes the visitors doubled their lead with Charlie Lambert breaking down the right and delivering a cross that came back to **BRYAN VILLAVICENCIO**, whose powerful drive came off the underside of the bar and a Heath defender before hitting the back of the net.

However, a disastrous moment let Heath back into contention after 39 minutes as Joe Stone's attempted hook away spun up in the air towards his own goal. Even then, it looked to be an easy gathering of the ball by **MITCH BROMAGE**, but he somehow managed to let it slip past him and over the line.

Just before the break Bromage made amends with a fine save to deny Dos Santos before Ryan Brackpool cleared, but just four minutes into the second half a penalty was awarded for a challenge by Brackpool and **TREVOR MCCREDDIE**, who had a brief spell with Bridges three years ago, struck an unstoppable penalty past Bromage for the equaliser.

Back came Bridges with Brannon O'Neill, who had earlier collided with one of the hoardings, being denied by the crossbar from a deep free kick, whilst Lambert stung Collings' hands with a well struck drive from twenty yards.

The 86th minute winner was just reward for **DAN PERRY**, who had often battled alone up front but never gave the Heath defence any respite. Brackpool's long ball forward found Perry with his back to goal just outside the goal area. One bounce gave him the chance to back header over the stranded Collings for a quite remarkable winner.

The first recorded football match took place in the town during October 1885 when, under the name "Whitstable United", a team played Whitstable College. Earliest use of the name "Whitstable Town" can be traced to the following season (1886-87) when matches were played on a Friday at "Mr. Saddleton's field" – an area of ground near the railway station. The use of the club's current Belmont ground began in January 1888 with a friendly game against Herne Bay. There was a change in name briefly to "Whitstable Swifts" in 1893 but reverted to "Whitstable Town" just two years later. Whitstable Town played their first competitive game in 1897 – a Kent Junior Cup match that resulted in a 7-1 defeat by Dover Star FC. Shortly after this, the club joined the "East Kent League" and later played in both the "New Brompton" and "Faversham & District" Leagues.

The club folded in 1904 only to be reformed in 1908. In 1908-09 Whitstable Town joined the Kent League Division 2 and achieved a respectable fourth place in their first season. Two teams were also entered in the Thanet League and they were both successful in lifting both the first and second division titles. The first FA Cup campaign came in 1910. A 3-2 victory over Folkestone preceded a defeat by Dartford in front of a crowd of estimated at 2,150. Following the First World War, Town re-joined the Kent League and remained in the competition until the outbreak of World War II.

The club won the Division 2 title in 1927-28 and 1933-34. However, the key success came in 1928-29 when the team lifted the Kent Amateur Cup (now superseded by the Kent Senior Trophy). After one season in the New Brompton League following the Second World War, Whitstable returned to Kent League in 1947-48 (also playing in the K Division of the New Brompton League). Success came to the club as they won the Division 2 title in the 1949-50 season and gained promotion to the First Division until the League disbanded in 1959. These were sometimes considered the glory years as Whitstable temporarily became a professional club but the problems of competing with much wealthier clubs proved difficult and put considerable pressure on the club's finances.

The loss of the Kent League came as a hammer blow. Wealthier clubs moved onward and upward to the more prestigious Southern League leaving behind a small band of teams fighting for survival. Town joined the Aetolian League briefly. Gone were the days of the money-spinning East Kent derby games against the likes of Folkestone, Dover, Sittingbourne and Margate. Matches against far off London-based sides were no substitute and, inevitably, the 1960's became a period of financial problems and decay. The end of the 1959-60 season saw Whitstable bottom of the Aetolian League and a decision was taken to drop into the Kent Amateur League for a short period – an all-time low for a senior side with such a rich history.

We were champions in 1960-61 and were runners up in the Kent Amateur Cup. At the end of the 1961-62 season a decision was taken to enter the Seanglian League for the following season but this was a disaster as Whitstable mixed with the second string of a number of larger local clubs. The club then had one season back in the Aetolian League before joining the Greater London League. One piece of success was that the Town finished runners up in the Greater London League Group B Cup in 1965-66 losing the final 3-1 against Crittall Athletic in the final staged at Cray Wanderers FC.

The Kent League was reformed in 1967 and Town re-joined immediately. However, this was not the Kent League of the "heady" 1930s and 1950s. Populated by a large number of reserve sides from Southern League clubs, there was little to appeal to supporters... but it was a start. Gradually, former Kent League clubs began to return. Some like Whitstable had wandered various leagues over the years. Others had encountered financial problems in the Southern League. At last, the League Management Committee was in a position to remove reserve sides from the competition and impose strict conditions governing grounds and facilities. East Kent derby matches became a reality once more – against Ramsgate, Canterbury City, Folkestone, Deal, Faversham Town, Chatham and, of course, our oldest and nearest rivals, Herne Bay.

The club responded – building a club house and attempting to restore the Belmont to its former glory on limited funds. The "Town" celebrated its centenary in 1985-86 in a healthier state and the occasion was marked by games against Charlton Athletic and Crystal Palace. Both matches attracted large crowds to the Belmont. There were many developments that followed the appointment of Joe Brownnett as chairman in the late 1980's and sponsorship by D&J Tyres of Herne Bay. Since then, dressing rooms have been refurbished, the club house re-fitted, floodlights erected, a new snack bar created, committee rooms extended, the pitch levelled and a drainage system installed.

Success on the pitch had been elusive since the re-formation of the Kent League. Despite a regular "top 10" position, the best league finishes had been two "third place" spots. Cup competitions yielded greater success but there has been heartache as well.... "Runners up" in Kent League Cup twice and the Kent Senior Trophy on three occasions. The only major reward came in 1979-80 – a 4-3 victory over Chatham to lift the Kent League Cup at the Bull Ground at Sittingbourne. Trailing 2-0 and 3-1 in the final, the team recovered to score two late goals and an "extra time" winner.

The club achieved its best FA Vase run during 1996-97. Despite being drawn away from home in virtually every round, Whitstable reached the last 16...just 3 matches from an appearance at Wembley in this nationwide competition. With everyone praying for a home draw, luck deserted us...North Ferriby United (near Hull) ...away. A tight 1-0 defeat ended the dream on Humberside.

In March 1989, the club and one of its most popular players (Gerry Allan) received coverage in the national press following one of the quickest goals in football history – timed at just over 4 seconds. From the kick off, the ball was rolled forward and Gerry attempted to lob the ball over the goalkeeper from the half way line. A slight miscue caused the ball to drop short but it skidded on the damp surface and passed under the goalkeeper's body. Everyone dived for the Guinness book of records but it seems that there have been slightly quicker strikes. Had Gerry made a clean connection, it might have been the fastest goal of all time!

Whitstable did enjoy some success in the 2000-01 season, winning the Kent Senior Trophy at the Central Park Stadium, Sittingbourne. They held a one goal lead until the last minute of the final when VCD equalised. There were no further goals in extra time, so the game was decided by penalty kicks. In a dramatic conclusion, following 26 penalties, Whitstable eventually won 10-9 with goalkeeper Lee Hook the hero.

Town's longest serving chairman Joe Brownnett stepped aside at the end of 2004-05 season when supporter Tony Rouse took over the chair. 2006-07 marked the best season in the club's history. Under player manager Marc Seager's leadership the team won the Kent League and the Kent Senior Trophy. A treble was just missed out on the last day of the season as we ended up as runners-up in the Kent League Cup. We also had a good run in the FA Cup ending with a narrow home defeat against Margate in front of 1,144 people.

The championship brought about the long awaited promotion to the Ryman League. The first year in the Ryman League (2007-2008) started shakily but an excellent end to the season brought us into mid-table and respectability with chairman Tony Rouse stepping aside and Joe Brownnett taking the reins as chairman once again. After a difficult start to the second season, it was a mirror image of the previous year as we found ourselves again in the lower reaches of mid-table.

The following five seasons saw a number of managerial changes with the side always providing a sprint finish to the season to ensure survival. Ex-referee, Gary Johnson, became chairman at the start of the 2012-13 season. Nicky Southall led the team to the last 32 of the FA Trophy in 2013-14, including memorable wins at Carshalton Athletic and Hendon before losing 2-1 to Ebbsfleet United in front of 742 supporters at the Belmont Ground. Jim and Danny Ward took over as the management team from Nicky Southall at the start of the 2014-15 season and produced the club's best position in the league, finishing in eighth place. The Wards moved back to manage Ramsgate after just one year and the whole of the season 2015-16 was one of constant change with managers and players coming and going. Chairman, Gary Johnson, then stepped down and Joe Brownnett once again was the safe pair of hands to settle the club down. Scott Porter was appointed manager in an attempt to avoid relegation, but despite some encouraging results it was not to be and the club dropped back to the Southern Counties East Football League.

The club regained stability off the pitch and Joe and Scott continued in their respective roles and a 5th place finish was achieved in 2016-17. The following season ended successfully with the team going on an incredible four month unbeaten run that brought two cup final wins, defeating Sheppey United in the Kent Senior Trophy and Tunbridge Wells in the SCEFL Challenge Cup. The main objective of promotion back into the Bostik (Isthmian) League was also achieved, as finishing runners-up to Sevenoaks Town was enough to restore Step 4 football to the Belmont. During the 2018-19 season, both chairman, Joe Brownnett, and manager, Scott Porter, announced that they would be standing down from their roles at the end of that season, although both would continue at the club in alternative positions. The team finished in a respectable 12th place to consolidate its status back at Step 4.

The club had set up a football academy at the start of the 2017-18 season and had begun to work closely with Whitstable Town Junior Football Club to offer more opportunities for young players. This relationship grew stronger and led to the two clubs joining together in June 2019 under a new chairman, Steve Clayton, who had held that position in the junior club. The ownership of the senior club was formally transferred from the unincorporated members club to a new company, limited by guarantee, on 1st June 2019, with a number of new officers being appointed. On the field, former Whitstable Town player and Ramsgate manager, Lloyd Blackman, was appointed the new manager and a reserves team was reintroduced into the Kent County League. Together with the growing football academy and youth section, a clear pathway had been established for young players in the town.

Following two Covid disrupted seasons and a poor start to the 2021-22 campaign, Lloyd Blackman resigned as first team manager in September 2021 and was replaced by former Thamesmead Town and VCD Athletic manager, Keith McMahon.

Previous clubs: Cray Wanderers, Dulwich Hamlet, Thamesmead Town, Tilbury, Grays Athletic, Aveley, Thurrock, Phoenix Sports, VCD, Brentwood, Burgess Hill, Romford, Waltham Abbey, Croydon.

Gus Barnes – Full Back/Winger – Age 17. Whitstable debut: August 2021. Whitstable Town U18 Kent Youth League player, who broke into the first team at the start of the 2021-22 season, playing as a wide forward.

James Brown – Left Back/Midfield – Age 29. Whitstable debut: November 2011 and re-joined for 2019-20 season. Former youth player at Gillingham and son of local footballing legend Neil Brown. Previous clubs: Faversham, Herne Bay and also had spells playing overseas.

Cameron Chamberlain – Centre Back – Age 17. Whitstable debut: January 2022. Whitstable Town U18 Kent Youth League defender and captain, who made his first team debut at Herne Bay in a cup game with over 500 in attendance.

Ollie Gray – Centre Back/Right Back/Midfield – Age 30. Whitstable debut: August 2014 and re-joined for 2020-21 season. Versatile player in his second spell at Whitstable. Previous clubs: QPR (youth), Margate, Ramsgate, Sittingbourne and Eastbourne Town.

Simon Kabamba – Right Back – Age 22. Whitstable debut: October 2020. Currently out with a knee injury sustained in pre-season. Previous club: Herne Bay
