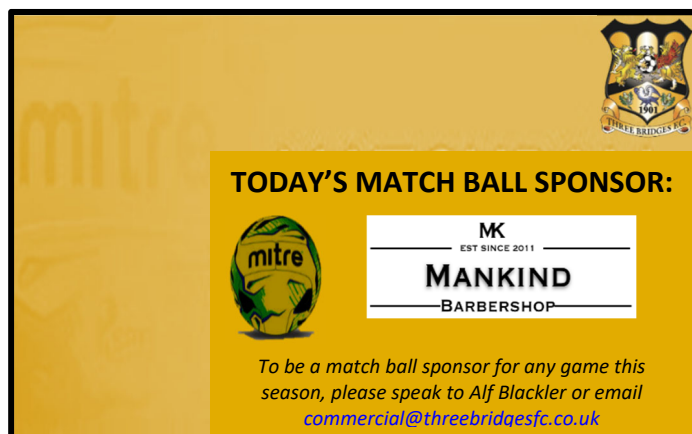
Back in November, we met Sittingbourne twice in the space of four days. First there was a goalless draw here in the League Cup before we lost 4-5 on penalties, and then we drew 1-1 away to them in the League with Dan Perry on target for us. Their last two games have resulted in good victories, 3-0 at home to Haywards Heath Town and 1-0 away to VCD Athletic, leaving them in 9th place with 46 points from their thirty games.

Our own form (the Senior Cup game against Worthing aside) has seen us in decent form, so today promises to be a good test for both sides. Dan Perry sits just one goal behind Ramsgate's Joshua Ajayi in the race to top scorer in our division, and with eight games left he will be hoping to finish ahead of all comers.

Meanwhile, our U18's Southern Combination side have their penultimate League game of the season here tomorrow when they face East Grinstead Town, whilst on Monday the U18's Isthmian League team welcome Hastings United to the Jubilee Field.

HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faili stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faili stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was a new manager for the U23s (Development Squad) with Ryan Gayler appointed as Manager and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 sees Jamie Crellin taking over as First Team Manager, with both Danny Lee and Lee Cole (former Academy manager and coach) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager and First Team coach respectively. The U23s have been disbanded but we will have an additional U18s playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays.

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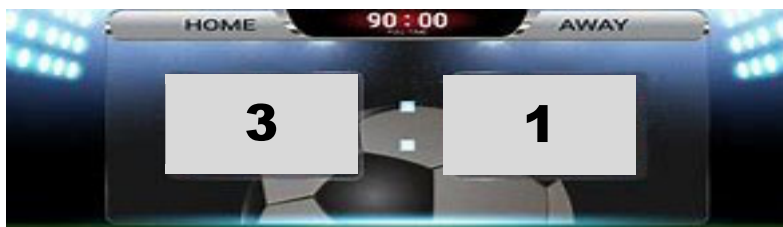
Views from Marina Jack

Dan Perry continued his free scoring streak with two more goals against bottom side Whitstable!

It took 24 minutes to grab his first as both Charlie Lambert and Joe Stone had seen chances go just too wide or too high. Brannon O'Neill, who was superb for Bridges with a real captain's performance of both grit and technical ability, provided a great cross to Stone, who then laid it to **DAN PERRY** for a clinical finish as he took advantage of a hesitant defence.

He almost added another after 39 minutes but keeper Dan Eason managed to tip the ball away for a corner, but it was from this set piece that Bridges doubled their advantage as O'Neill played it neatly into the path of **CURTIS GAYLER**, who had made a run from deep to connect with a glorious finish into the far top corner of Eason's net.

The second half opened with Whitstable needing to make two clearances off their line and then Gayler created an opening for himself before somehow blasting over the bar! After 53 minutes came another special piece of football as Stone and Lambert combined to set up **DAN PERRY** for a glorious volley.

Bridges continued to drive forward and Eason just held onto another Gayler effort before kicking away a drive from Lambert. Gayler then drove over again as there was almost a repeat of his goal from another O'Neill corner, but in the 71st minute Whitstable grabbed what proved to be no more than a consolation goal when substitute **STEPHEN OKOH** saw his shot take a wicked deflection off Tadley Bromage to wrongfoot his brother Mitch in goal.

Another free kick by Gayler was somehow scraped away at the last moment, and in a rare attack by the visitors, another substitute George McIlroy forced Mitch Bromage into a save but the home defence was rarely troubled by the Whitstable attack, although no one could fault the endeavour and experience shown by often lone striker Harry Goodger.



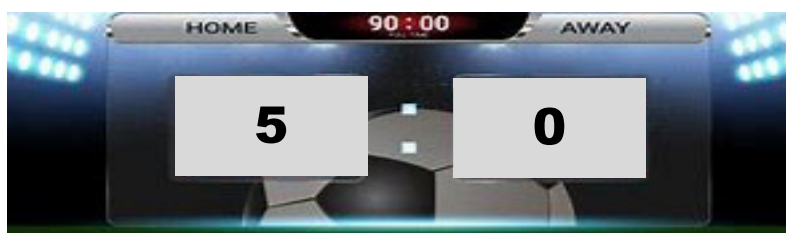


SUSSEX SENIOR CHALLENGE CUP – SEMI-FINAL

There are times when you have to admit that you have faced a much stronger team. This was one such occasion with Bridges Manager, Jamie Crellin, heaping praise on “a very good team” in Isthmian League Premier Division leaders Worthing, who look likely to be playing National League South fixtures next season.

They dominated possession throughout this semi final, and yet Bridges keeper Mitch Bromage only faced two shots of note throughout a first half in which the side defended stoutly. Bromage made a good block to deny Aarran Racine after 18 minutes before being beaten 20 minutes later. He had punched the ball away but only as far as **JASPER PATTENDEN**, whose shot squeezed through a crowd of players past an unsighted Bromage, who led the protests that another Worthing player had impeded him from an offside position.

However, Worthing stepped up another gear after the break and a swift move after 53 minutes left **Reece Myles-Meekums** free to stab home the Rebels’ second goal.

With Marvin Armstrong dominating midfield, another goal seemed inevitable, but it was Bridges who at last tested Harrison Male after 68 minutes when Curtis Gayler latched onto Dan Ferreria’s pass to shoot from just outside the goal area, but it was soon Worthing back into their stride with Bromage having to make a fine save to deny substitute Oliver Pearce.

After 70 minutes a corner fell to **DAVIDE RODARI**, who rifled home before being substituted, and just a minute later a low cross was met by **CALLUM KEALY** for number four.

The introduction of Camron Lawson from the Bridges bench gave his side a lift even though **MYLES-MEEKUMS** slotted a fifth in the 80th minute. Dan Perry, who had battled unselfishly throughout with little reward, at last managed to test Male, who then saved with his foot from Lawson and in the closing stages Gayler shot over the bar.

At least Bridges never gave up, but they knew they had lost to a side who will take some beating when the Final takes place at the Amex in May.

A fantastic victory away to a team placed second in the League, although a home win looked likely in the opening stages as Cray gained four corners in the first five minutes!

Bridges settled with captain Brannon O'Neill looking commanding and the defence showing remarkable stubbornness and it took 32 minutes for Cray to seriously test Mitch Bromage, who denied danger man Marcel Barrington.

Bridges had a couple of half chances themselves, but the first half generally proved to be more about defenders than attackers after that opening five minutes. Gianni Ashley was finding Denzel Gayle a particularly tricky pacey opponent, but it didn't take long for Ashley to get Gayler's measure, and dangerous moments were few and far between.

Bridges opened up more after the break and grabbed the lead after 58 minutes. Camron Lawson made a brilliant break down the left flank and his low cross had Cray's defence all at sea. As Dan Perry threatened to meet the cross, all Cray's captain **CONNOR DYMOND** could do was knock it over the line himself.

A bobbling shot by Denzel Gayle was well gathered by Mitch Bromage, but he was beaten in the 70th minute after twice blocking fierce shots only for **CONNOR DYMOND** to make it a goal at both ends with a drive from the edge of the box through a packed goalmouth.

Back came Bridges with Charlie Lambert and Perry driving wide of respective far posts. Curtis Gayler created the second of those chances and he also set up O'Neill, whose decent shot was diverted for a corner.

However, after 84 minutes came a controversial winner, a long ball being played over for **DAN PERRY** to collect. It looked as though he'd hand balled as it fell into his path, but he then finished with a flourish and the assistant referee was insistent that the ball had come off Perry's shoulder.

Cray weren't able to create any sort of equalising chance and Bridges deserved this victory by the final whistle.

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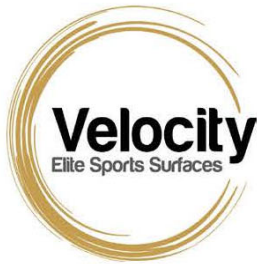

The club was started as Sittingbourne United back in 1881. In 1886 it became Sittingbourne Football Club and played at the Bull Ground in the centre of town. In 1892 the club gained senior status and the club won its first major title in 1897/98 when it won the Kent League.

The Kent Senior Cup followed in 1902. After the First World War more senior cup and league titles followed with the club also enjoying the first of three spells in the Southern League. Success followed and in another spell in the Southern League Sittingbourne twice in succession missed promotion to the Premier Division only on goal average.

The club reached the first-round proper of the FA Cup in 1962 but lost 3-0 at Hinckley Athletic. Back in the Kent League Sittingbourne were one of the strongest teams throughout the 1970s and 1980s in an era – unlike the one that followed, when what happened on the field got more attention than what went on off it!

In February 1990, the club decided to sell its town centre Bull Ground (now Sainsbury's supermarket) and buy a 23-acre site on the town's Eurolink estate. A magnificent stadium with a 2,000-seater stand, restaurants, bars, sumptuous dressing rooms, greyhound track and training pitches was the envy of non-league football. There was success too, on the pitch when, in their first season at Central Park, Sittingbourne won the Winstonlead Kent League without losing a game – the only senior football team throughout Europe to achieve that feat in the 1990/91 season. Promotion to the Beazer Homes Southern League followed with the championship of the Southern Division secured in 1993 followed by promotion to highest level achieved by the club since its foundation in 1891. The ground record was broken five times during that one season with 5,951 spectators watching a friendly with Spurs and more than 3,000 at the match with local rivals Gravesend – a Beazer Homes Southern Division record.

More money flowed in with the £21,000 sale of Neil Emblen and Mickey Harle to Millwall before the bubble spectacularly burst. Debts of more than £1 million were revealed, the team got relegated, the ground was closed for a while, despite the intervention of the local council in taking it over, and the club was officially wound up. Somehow Sittingbourne survived it all and even got back to the Southern Premier Division during this traumatic time (in Steve Lovell's first spell as manager), finishing an equal highest ever eighth place before the financial problems again began to bite and relegation followed. A new management committee headed by Andy Spice made great strides in tackling the debt problem and getting Sittingbourne Football Club back on an even keel financially. To ensure survival of the club, the decision was made to move out of the imposing main stadium and move to another pitch on the complex.

Because of the FA reorganising the leagues Sittingbourne faced a brand-new challenge playing a number of "unknown" teams in the Ryman Isthmian League for season 2006-2007. The 2009-10 season, was one of the best since the financial problems, Sittingbourne being in play-off contention for much of the time but failing at the end. Still, a 9th place finish was no disgrace and for the first time in fifty years, Sittingbourne won the Kent Senior Cup in front of 618 at Folkstone Invicta.

For the 2013-2014 season, Sittingbourne decided to leave their home of 10 years and accept an invitation to move to Woodstock Park, a 14-acre area with superb social facilities. Andy Spice, who almost single-handedly kept Sittingbourne as a senior club, stood down as Chairman making way for Maurice Dunk, a Director of the company that holds the leasehold for Woodstock Park.

After a three year reign as manager, Nick Davis resigned, in February 2018 after the committee decided a budget cut was necessary when it became clear that Sittingbourne would be unlikely to challenge for the play offs. Coach, Aslan Odev took over and, after initially taking The Brickies to the play off places, failed to maintain this and after a number of losses it was mutually agreed that he would stand aside, paving the way in January 2019, for Dover Athletic Academy development manager, Chris Lynch, to take over.

Darren Blackburn took over for the 2020-21 season and has completely reshaped the team. Due to Covid 19, Darren has not had a chance to make his mark on the club and is hoping the 2021-2022 season will change that.



SITTINGBOURNE FC

HARRY BROOKS (Goalkeeper): Signed for us on dual registration from Tunbridge Wells in September 2021 to help out when regular goalkeeper, Joe Docherty, was away. He has now made the number one spot his own. This is Harry's second spell with us. His first was in the 2018-19 season. He then went on to play for Whitstable (His second spell with them) and Norwegian side, Volga TI, Back to England then he played for Ramsgate before moving abroad again to play for Ytterhogdal, Sweden.

TAYLOR FISHER (Defender): Joined Sittingbourne for the start of the 2021-22 season. He is the son of Sittingbourne legend, Dave Fisher. Taylor has made the left back position his own since he joined The Bourne. He has had experience with Lordswood, Whitstable Town, Dartford and Beckenham Town.

SAMUEL OKOYE-AHANKEU (Defender): Former Arsenal schoolboy who signed from Hitchin Town in September 2012. He has also played for Wingate & Finchley. Samuel was on trial at Watford in the summer and did well. However contractual difficulties with another club made it difficult for him to sign for a club at that level.

SAM FLISHER (Defender): Sam made his debut in the summer of 2020. His previous club was Bearsted. He has also played for Hollands & Blair.

EMMANUEL DASHO (Defender): Very quick defender who likes to go forward. Emmanuel signed from Sevenoaks Town having previously played for Glebe, Walthamstow and Witham Town.

LEX ALLAN (Defender): Six feet seven inch centre-back who departed Woodstock Park in October 2020 for Sheppey United and re-joined The Brickies in January 2022. Lex first became a Brickie's first team regular when he was only 18 years old, back in the 2017-18 season. His form quickly attracted the attention of the likes of Millwall, Crystal Palace, Fulham and Birmingham City, but it was with the Brickies he remained, and he made 26 appearances in that first campaign, 25 more during 2018-19, and 35 during 2019-20.

HARRISON PONT (Midfield): Started with Dover Athletic academy and whilst playing for them he joined us on dual transfer for his first spell at the club. Has also played for Hollands & Blair and Margate.

IBRAHIM BAMBA (Midfield): Ibrahim signed in January 2022. He was recommended to The Brickies by Dartford who he had been training with. He was previously with Southern Combination side Eastbourne United Association and has also played in France and Switzerland.

ETHAN SMITH (Midfield): Ethan is on Gillingham's books and joined the Brickies in February 2022 to get more experience. He has also played for Faversham Town.

HARRY MILLER (Midfield): Made his debut for Sittingbourne in March 2020. Harry is son of ex-Sittingbourne legend Mark Miller and nephew of another Sittingbourne legend, Neil Miller.

TOBY BANCROFT (Midfield / Forward): Another to join Sittingbourne at the beginning of the 2021-2022 season. Toby's last team was Margate when he was on loan from Gillingham. Toby has also previously played for Ramsgate and Wingate & Finchley.

KANE ROWLAND (Forward): Kane started in the youth set up at Ramsgate before joining Whitstable Town and scored 16 goals whilst with them. He then joined Margate before returning to Whitstable where he scored another 30 goals. The Ward brothers then took Kane to Ramsgate. Kane signed for us in the 2017-18 season. His consistent high quality play, that included him scoring 23 goals for us despite missing quite a few games because of injury, came to the attention of Folkestone Invicta who signed him. Kane re-joined us for the beginning of the curtailed 2019-20 season.

JOHAN CANEY-BRYAN (Forward): Joined Sittingbourne at the beginning of the 2018-2019 season. Immediately made an impact when he scored two goals in a pre-season friendly. Johan was awarded a scholarship at the University of East London whilst being a third-year sport and exercise student following an impressive display playing for The UEL Football Club.
