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HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faii stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faii stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was Ryan Gayler appointed as the new manager for the U23s (Development Squad), assisted by Tom Hayward and Chris Irving, and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 sees Jamie Crellin taking over as First Team Manager, with both Danny Lee and Lee Cole (former Academy manager and coach) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager and First Team coach respectively. The U23s (Development Squad) has been disbanded, but we will have an additional U18s playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays.

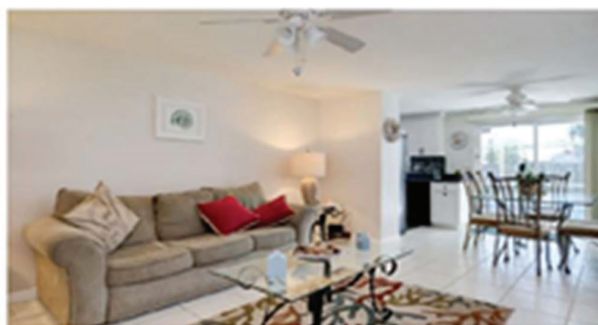

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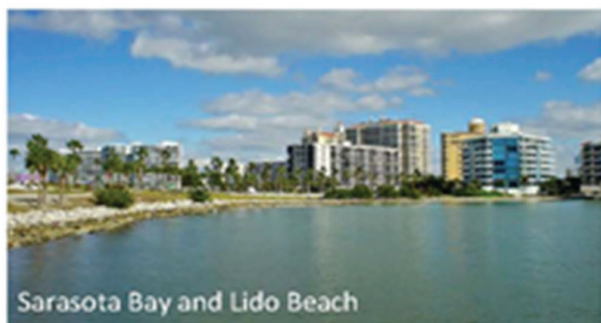
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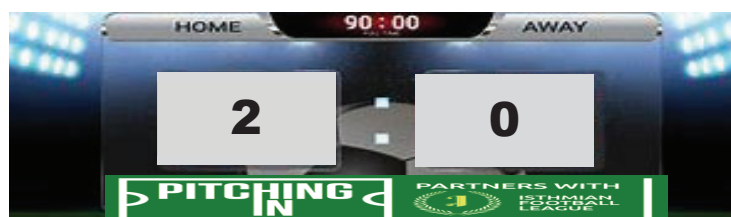
Views from Marina Jack

An excellent victory which made up for the rather dismal display at Sevenoaks three days earlier.

All the Bridges players seemed determined to put that defeat behind them against a VCD side fancied to do well this season, with great performances by youngsters such as Billy Irving and Dan Ferreira, whilst the more experienced players like Brannon O'Neill and Kieron Pamment gave great balance to the side.

The only shame was that there were two red cards shown just before the half hour. It seemed initially just two players vying for possession, but the inevitable pushing and shoving match followed before Bryan Villavicencio and Joe Bingham were dismissed.

Bridges were already ahead by then thanks to a 16th minute strike from eight yards by **KIERON PAMMENT** following a lovely low cross by Camron Lawson and determined play in the box by Noel Leighton.

Curtis Gayler almost doubled the score with a free kick that was parried away by giant keeper George Kamurasi, whilst at the other end Leo Anderson brilliantly tipped over a strike by Youssef Bamba.

The second half started perfectly for Bridges with a goal inside four minutes, Lawson and Leighton both causing havoc in the VCD defence before **KEVIN RIVERA** drove home from a similar distance to Pamment.

Rivera saw another effort blocked by Kamurasi with the ball running wide to Lawson, whose cross nearly produced an own goal.

VCD rarely troubled a solid Bridges defence, and three points were well deserved for the home team at the final whistle.

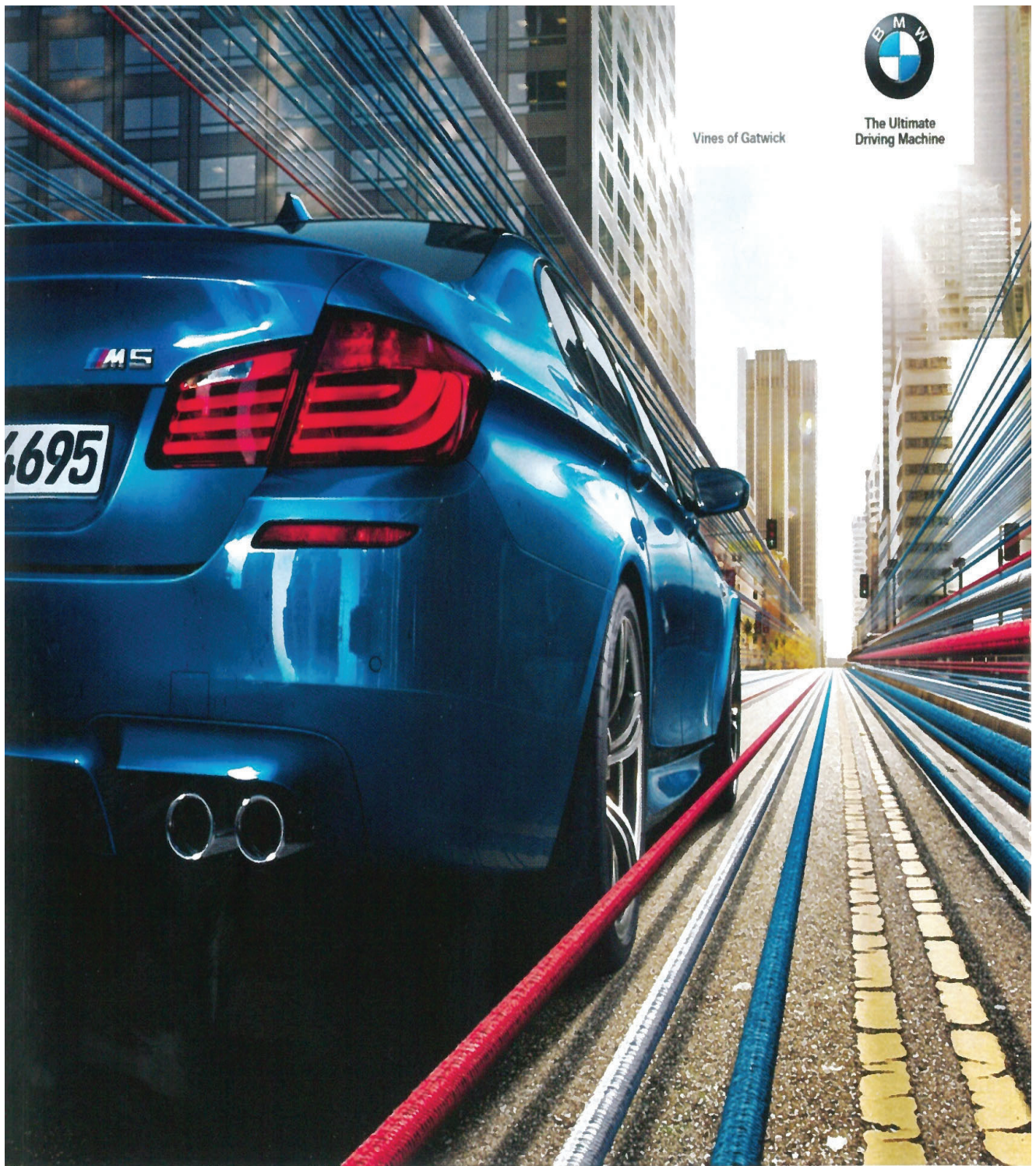

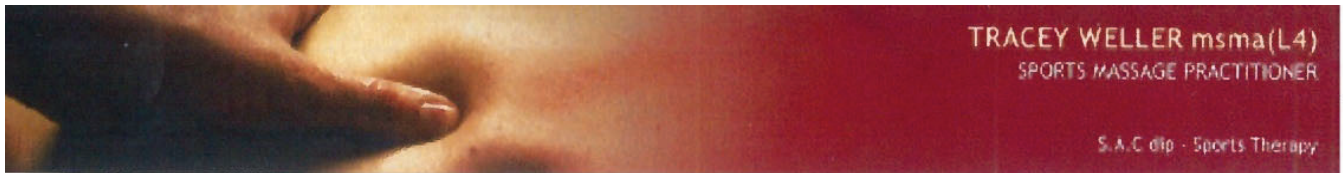

DEAL TOWN FC

Deal Town FC were formed in 1921 taking over from the Deal Discharged Sailors and Soldiers FC that replaced the Deal Cinque Ports FC in 1920. The Cinque Ports Club had been in existence from the early 1900s.

For the first 50 years or so of their existence the Hoops played at various times in the old Kent League or Kent Amateur League and in the 1950s they enjoyed one of their most successful periods, winning the Kent League title in 1954 and the Kent League Cup in 1958, when they beat Margate 3-0 in the final, before the KL was disbanded the following year.

Deal then became one of the founder members of the Aetolian League in 1959, where they finished runners-up in their first season, before leaving that league to join the Southern League in 1963. However, after enduring three torrid seasons in the Southern League, Deal switched leagues again in 1966 when they joined the Greater London League.

Deal spent five seasons in the Greater London League, with the highlight coming in 1968 when they won the League Cup by beating East Ham Utd 2-1 after extra-time, but when the league merged with the Spartan League at the end of the 1970-71 season, Deal's first team opted not to join the merged league and instead took over from their reserve side in the newly-reborn Kent League.

The club's next trophy success came 11 years later when they won the Kent League Cup by defeating Erith & Belvedere in the 1982 final, but trophies again proved hard to come by in the ensuing years. That was all to change however after Roy Smith took over as chairman in 1997, and his ambitions both on and off the field quickly lifted the club. Smith appointed a full-time manager in Tommy Sampson for the beginning of the 1998-99 season, which ended with the club winning the Kent League Cup by beating VCD Athletic in the final, and the Hoops then enjoyed the greatest season in their history the following year. Deal became the first team from Kent to lift the FA Vase with their 1-0 victory at Wembley Stadium against Chippenham Town thanks to Roly Graham's superb late volley, and for good measure they also won the Kent League title.

However, the Hoops' fortunes quickly went downhill after Smith and Sampson left the Charles Ground before the start of the 2000-01 season. Dave Dadd took over as manager for that campaign and then became assistant manager when Simon Bryant took charge the following year. Bryant led the team to creditable third and fourth place finishes in his two seasons as manager before taking over at Herne Bay. With the majority of Bryant's players also leaving it was again a case of having to rebuild and this time the task fell to Derek Hares, who had enjoyed two successful seasons as the Hoops reserve team manager and, apart from a couple of years from 2013-15 when he became chairman, Hares remained in charge of the first team until he stepped down in June 2022 to be replaced with Steve King who had been Assistant Manager for several years.

The 2018-19 campaign saw Deal again spend virtually all of the season in the top half of the table only to lose three of their last four games which meant the Hoops eventually finished in 11th place, and Hares and head coach Steve King were certainly hoping to improve on that position in 2019/20 only for it to be terminated early due to the Covid situation. The season 2020/21 was again cut short because of Covid but results were looking more positive. Things certainly did improve in the 2021/22 season as we finished in our highest position, 4th, for almost 20 years. We now look forward to bettering that.

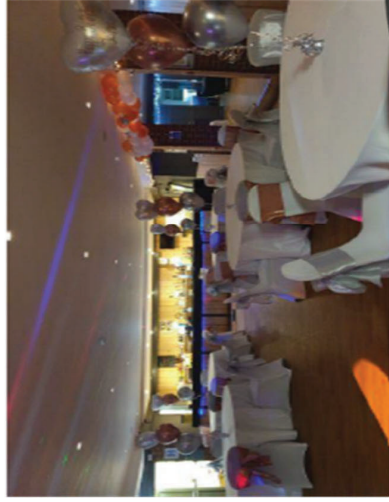
