Good afternoon and welcome to the Jubilee Field for our game against **FAVERSHAM TOWN FC**, to whom we extend a warm (hopefully) welcome along with today's match officials.

Faversham find themselves in bottom place in the table, a strange position for a team who have been usually found competing for honours rather than battling against relegation. They have just 7 points from their 15 League games, although one of their two victories came a few weeks ago when they beat East Grinstead Town 3-1 at home. November wasn't good for them on their travels as they lost 5-0 at both VCD Athletic and Cray Valley PM, but their record of one point from seven away fixtures is actually better by one than ours on the road!

Last season we drew 1-1 at home to them, Tad Bromage being our scorer, whilst we lost 3-1 in the away game, with Noel Leighton scoring for us.

Our last two games have been entertaining affairs with many suggesting that our opponents were better than us on the day. Certainly you could see why Chatham Town are near the top of the table, but we ground out a welcome victory last Saturday. Callum Donaghey proved to be the hero with his first goal of the season, but on Tuesday night he turned villain with two yellow cards against a skilful young Brighton side in the Sussex Senior Cup. It was the turn of Joe Stone to grab his first goal of the season in that game, leaving it late with just two minutes of added time remaining. A good 1-1 draw for us but disappointing in the end with a 2-4 loss on penalties.

Our next home game is in two weeks when we entertain Sheppey United, but before that we travel to in-form Littlehampton Town next Saturday. **If you haven't already heard, note that this game has a 1.00 p.m. kick off time.**

Meanwhile, our U18s will be at home on Monday night (28th November) when they host Worthing in a top of the table clash with just goal difference separating the two teams.

## HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faili stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faili stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was a new manager for the U23s (Development Squad) with Ryan Gayler appointed as Manager and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 saw Jamie Crellin take over as First Team Manager, with Danny Lee (former Academy manager) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager. The U23s were disbanded but we had an additional U18s (all U16s) playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays but this year playing in the U17s division.

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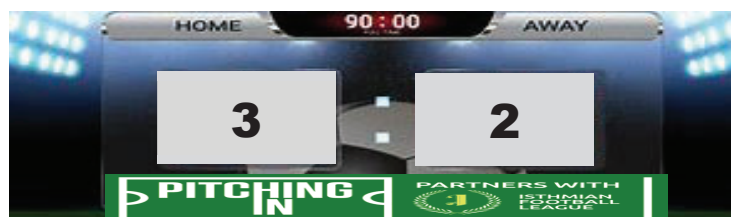

This was a game which at times proved an end-to-end affair and which promotion chasing Chatham dominated for long spells but the Bridges defence proved resilient, whilst keeper, Leo Anderson, made a number of excellent saves.

After a low shot by Brannon O'Neill had been saved early on, Anderson was forced to tip over a Jack Evans strike and then he unbelievably turned away a goal bound header by Emmanuel Oloyede.

Chatham's pace showed why they are near the top of the table, but two goals in a minute gave Bridges a flattering first half lead. After 35 minutes a dangerous free kick by **BRANNON O'NEILL** was helped on its way by a deflection, and a minute later a sloppy back pass gave **NOEL LEIGHTON** the opportunity to slip past the on-rushing keeper, Ben Bridle-Card.

Chatham made a couple of half time changes and looked immediately dangerous with Anderson making another great save from Evans' free kick, but the visitors' pressure finally told after 68 minutes when one of those substitutes, Callum Peck, delivered the perfect cross for **DAN BRADSHAW** to head home at the far post with Anderson almost keeping that one out too.

Time for Bridges to make two substitutes of their own which at first glance suggested a reinforcement of defenders but in the 83rd minute, Billy Irving reacted quickest to put the ball back in the danger area and **CALLUM DONAGHEY** dived to head home.

Chatham though weren't giving up just yet. Having already seen one effort cleared off the line, it was super sub Peck again who provided a delicate 86th minute chip for **EMMANUEL OLOYEDE** to finish.

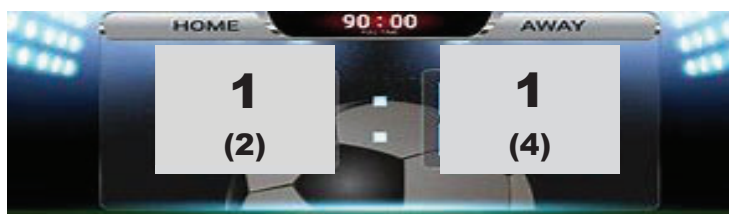
The final few minutes were largely back to the wall defiance by Bridges, who somehow managed to cling on for three very welcome points.

This was a strange evening for both Bridges skipper Brannon O'Neill and keeper Mitch Bromage. Both played well on the night with Bromage, in particular, making a number of good saves against a talented young Brighton outfit. However, O'Neill earned a yellow card for a late challenge, whilst the two of them were then involved in a crazy own goal – and to complete their misery, both missed penalties in the shoot out after the sides had drawn 1-1.

Bromage's first notable save came from Marcus Ifill, who was a constant threat all night, mainly on the right wing. Another good run by him was again thwarted by Bromage, whose best save came from a point blank Billy Clarke header.

Ifill then created a great chance for Imari Samuels, who incredibly missed, and this gave heart to Bridges with Kieron Pamment forcing Killian Cahill to a good low save. The turning point looked to be **Callum Donaghey's** second yellow card just after the hour, but Brighton went ahead after 65 minutes with a bizarre own goal. A cross from the left reached **BRANNON O'NEILL** on his own in the box, and he chested the ball down towards Bromage, who unfortunately was moving in the opposite direction and couldn't quite prevent it from going over the line!

The Bridges defence showed admirable strength and desire not to be beaten again with Joe Tennent a rock in the heart of a never say die back line. Clarke fired over and Sam Packham's low drive was gathered by Bromage. The one goal difference gave Bridges continued hope and with three minutes of normal time remaining, Joe Stone seemed set to net as he broke through only for Cahill to push the shot away for a corner. Tressor Difika got a header to the corner but Cahill gathered comfortably.

Just two minutes into the four added, a long throw by Billy Irving to the near post was bundled in by **JOE STONE** to leave the game having to be settled by a penalty shoot out, something that Crawley Town had suffered in their Senior Cup loss at Hastings.

Packham, Matt Everitt, Samuels and Ben Wilson all slotted for Brighton, whilst Curtis Gayler, having his first game following injury, started well enough for Bridges but O'Neill's effort was denied by the woodwork and the keeper combined. Pamment gave Bridges hope, but Bromage's night ended in disappointment despite him almost saving three of Brighton's efforts as he took Bridges' fourth penalty himself and sadly drove it over the goal and outside the ground!

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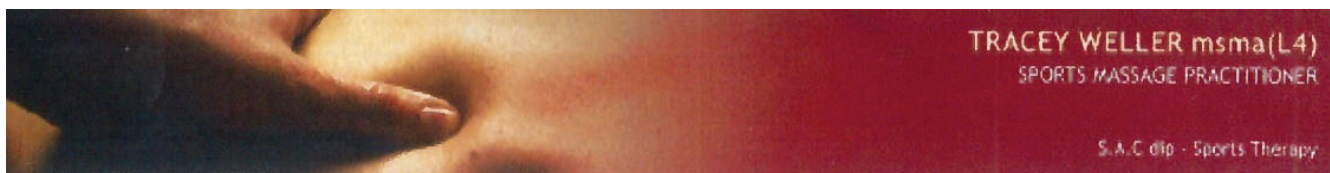

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# FAVERSHAM TOWN

Faversham Town play in white shirts with black trim, black shorts with white trim and black socks. Their away kit is blue with white trim.

The club's origins go back to 1884, and they entered the Kent League for the first time a decade later. The club name however was not really consistent, with the team turning out as Faversham Town, Faversham Invicta, Faversham Services, Faversham Railway and Faversham Rangers among others before being disbanded shortly before the Second World War.

Faversham Town reformed after the war and entered the Kent League in 1947. The club moved to its current home - Salters Lane the following year. Faversham Town had a decent amateur side but found the going tough against some of the professional Kent League clubs. Nevertheless, they won the Kent Amateur Cup in 1957 and 1959.

With the Kent League folding in 1959, the club had spells in both the Aetolian and Greater London leagues before rejoining the revived Kent League in 1968. Success soon followed. They were Kent League champions in 1970 and 1971, and lifted the Kent Amateur Cup three years in a row between 1972 and 1974.

After a brief flirtation with the Athenian League in the mid 70s, the club returned to the Kent League, winning the Kent Senior Trophy in 1977. The following season they repeated this success and were also crowned Kent League champions, completing a famous "double".

The Lilywhites won the Kent League again in 1990, but league form dipped in the 92/93 season and was to stay that way for several seasons. The club managed to reach the final of the Kent League Challenge Cup in 2000, but things were in rapid decline. Matters reached crisis point in 2003, when the KCFA suspended the club for non-payment of fines, with the club's operators blaming just about everyone for the mess except themselves. In the following months, the once proud Salters Lane ground was systematically wrecked by vandals. Meanwhile, club trustees led by businessman Ray Leader fought a desperate battle to heal a widening rift with the previous regime over the ownership of the club and ground.

In a separate development, the Faversham Town Independent Supporters Club had been formed, and quickly gained a membership of over 300 paid up members in the market town. This was despite the fact the club had no team, no manager, and a ground that had been totally wrecked by vandals and now resembled a bomb site. Perhaps the real turning point came when trustees and Independent Supporters Club committee members got together and declared an alliance to get the club back on its feet. An interim club committee was formed, and the long road to recovery was started.

The revival was slow, but things finally started to happen. The ownership dispute was settled and access to the ground obtained. Volunteer workers were confronted with completely smashed and vandalised buildings, and shoulder-height grass on what had been the pitch. A massive clear up operation began but it was back breaking work. Meanwhile, paperwork was put in order with a new club constitution written and agreed. Kent County FA allowed the club to retain their coveted senior status subject to several conditions. Local authority grants were applied for and secured, sponsorship deals obtained, and the club embarked on a range of fund raising initiatives. Slowly but surely, Salters Lane was returned to its former glory, before the future became even brighter with the erection of brand new floodlights. The revival of club and ground from the jaws of death was nothing short of a miracle - a story that would surely rival the efforts to revive both "The Valley" at Charlton, and Accrington Stanley F.C.

The revived club played their first season back in 05/06, competing in the Kent County League and finishing as runners-up. Having passed ground inspections and fulfilled minimum criteria, promotion to the Kent League was confirmed, and Faversham Town had at last "come home".

Season 2007/08 saw the arrival of Justin Luchford and Jimmy Strouts taking over the management with Town second bottom of the league. The team sunk to bottom before the pair gradually steered them up to mid table. Strouts soon left for personal reasons and Luchford, along with Clive Walker, took the Lilywhites to the Kent Senior Trophy final in season 2009/10, beating Greenwich 2-1 to lift the trophy. A week later, they were crowned Kent League Premier Division champions.

Towards the end of his first season in the Ryman League, and with Town within touching distance of the play-offs, Luchford resigned. His place was taken by his assistant Ray Turner. Turner took charge of the last seven league games securing eighth spot - the highest position of any Kent team competing at that level.

Another significant milestone was reached in 2010 when the revamped stadium was renamed Shepherd Neame Stadium after a sponsorship deal with the town's famous brewery.

Having consolidated their position as a mid-table Ryman South side during the first two years of Turner's reign, Faversham embarked on one of the best seasons in the club's history during the 2012/13 season.

The Lilywhites lost just three away league games all campaign on their way to finish third and reach the Ryman South play-off final against all odds. However, at Maidstone United's newly-built Gallagher Stadium in front of a 2,226 strong-crowd, Town were unable to pull off one final upset against a side with huge investment and backing. Maidstone cruising to a 3-0 victory to deny Faversham their first tastes of Ryman Premier League football.

Town spent the majority of the 2013/14 campaign just outside the play-offs, and ultimately had to settle for tenth position in their fourth season in the Ryman South. Off the pitch, Town continued to grow with another significant advance. They came together with nearby Faversham Town Youth & Juniors to form a new youth section, meaning boys were now playing in the famous white and black kit from the age of five. The move also created a route through from youth development into the senior side and enabled the newly-expanded club achieved FA Charter Standard Community Club rank, marking their rise in status.



# FAVERSHAM TOWN

The Lilywhites took another step forward in February 2014 with the announcement of an ambitious project to redevelop Shepherd Neame Stadium. The plans - broken down into five phases - include rebuilding the changing rooms, adding hospitality and function rooms, extra seating in the stands and a new stadium entrance. A coffee shop and retail store will then be added, with meeting rooms and offices also being built to bring in additional revenue. A new 120-seater stand, fitness centre and sports hall will also be built. Fundraising for the project then began.

Faversham had a productive 2014/15 season, scoring 111 league goals - more than any other Ryman League side that campaign - and amassing a record 97 points to finish in third place in the Ryman South for the second time in three seasons. But the club suffered more play-off heartache, as they lost 5-4 on penalties at home to Merstham in their Ryman South Play-off Semi-Final following a goalless draw away.

Faversham came fifth at the end of the 2015-16 season, again reaching the play-offs, but after beating Dorking Wanderers 2-1 in the semi-final they lost 3-0 to Worthing in the final, leaving them knocking once more on the door of the Ryman Premier Division.

The 2016/17 season was one of transition for the Lilywhites on the pitch, and success off it as they forged ahead with Phase One their ambitious rebuilding programme.

A tenth place finish was achieved with a young squad as manager Ray Turner dealt with a number of unexpected player departures, which led to a mid-season wobble. However, in May 2017 MP Helen Whately opened the new changing rooms as the first stage of the stadium redevelopment was finally completed. Another significant advance came when, for the first time, the club were able to field Kent Youth League standard squads at every age group from Under 13s upwards in the 2017/18 campaign, a mark of their growing stature in the region and of their commitment to a successful youth policy. In a further development, the Under 21s also switched to become an Under 23 Development team with the aim of helping young players bridge the gap from the Under 18s to the first team. The progress marked the fruition of a vision set out five years earlier by Ray Turner and Head of Youth Chris Greenfield, who was promoted to Under 23s Manager.

In 2018/19, a disappointing start to the season led to Ray Turner stepping aside. Phil Miles and Dan Chapman were appointed as joint managers in his place. The lacklustre season continued, and in the end the team finished 17th, two places and ten points clear of relegation.

Towards the end of the season, Paul Gates and Keith Chilvers were appointed joint managers of the renewed Under 23s squad, and senior players were let go in favour of rebuilding the team with a greater emphasis on promoting youth into the first team.

After an indifferent start to the 2019/20 season, Town parted company with their joint managers in October. In their place, new manager James Collins brought in assistant Nick Davis and Coach Brad Sandeman. A huge influx of players, coupled with the departure of players including club stalwart Matt Bourne - the club's record appearance holder - meant that by December a new-look squad was taking to the field and a new era had begun.

As the club looked to attract more sponsorship to fund its ambitions, the stadium was renamed Aquatherm Stadium after an agreement with the multinational pipe manufacturers.

The curtailed 2020/21 season saw Town finished their six games unbeaten, despite playing all of the promotion favourites, indicating that the club had turned the corner.

And ahead of the 2021/22 campaign the club signed its biggest ever shirts deal with Smart Office Solutions.

Despite a creditable 12th place finish the season ended on a low with Chairman (Paul Bennett) and Manager (James Collins) resigning within days of each other.



In came Gary Smart owner of SOS (shirt sponsor) who then appointed John Embery and Jermaine Darlington as joint managers.

The club parted company with the two joint managers after another disappointing result on Saturday, 15th October





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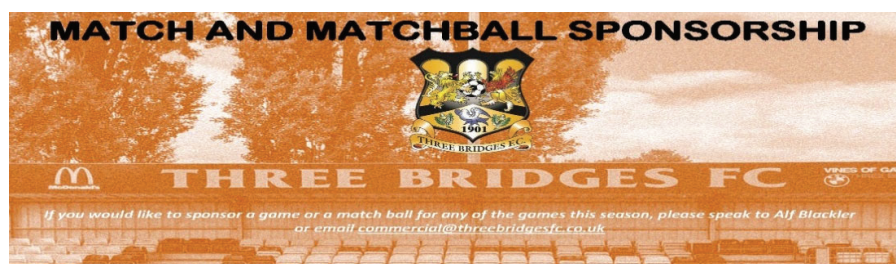
