Good afternoon everyone and welcome to the players, officials and supporters of **RAMSGATE FOOTBALL CLUB** along with today's match officials.

We'll be hoping that the weather will be kind to us today as, following only two games played in December, we have only played once in January and that was on the Bank Holiday Monday.

Postponements have been a real headache for us both home and away, firstly through waterlogged pitches and then frozen ones! Hythe Town will hopefully be here this coming Tuesday evening (31st) at the third time of asking, whilst we have games scheduled for every Tuesday night in February, albeit that one of those – the away match at East Grinstead Town on Valentines Day – was already in the original calendar.

Ramsgate meanwhile have not suffered as much, aided by a 3G pitch of course, and last Saturday they came from behind to beat Burgess Hill Town 4-1 at home to maintain their spot at the top of the League with 46 points from their 22 games, a point ahead from one game more of Chatham Town, who we are scheduled to meet away next Saturday.

Our results against Ramsgate last season were a 2-2 home draw in August 2021 with Ryan Brackpool and Brannon O'Neill on target for us, whilst we then lost 2-0 away to them in December of that year. In November 2022, we lost 4-1 there with a penalty from Brannon O'Neill being our only reward in a game where the final scoreline seemed flattering even to many of the home contingent.

HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faii stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faii stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was a new manager for the U23s (Development Squad) with Ryan Gayler appointed as Manager and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 saw Jamie Crellin take over as First Team Manager, with Danny Lee (former Academy manager) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager. The U23s were disbanded but we had an additional U18s (all U16s) playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays but this year playing in the U17s division.

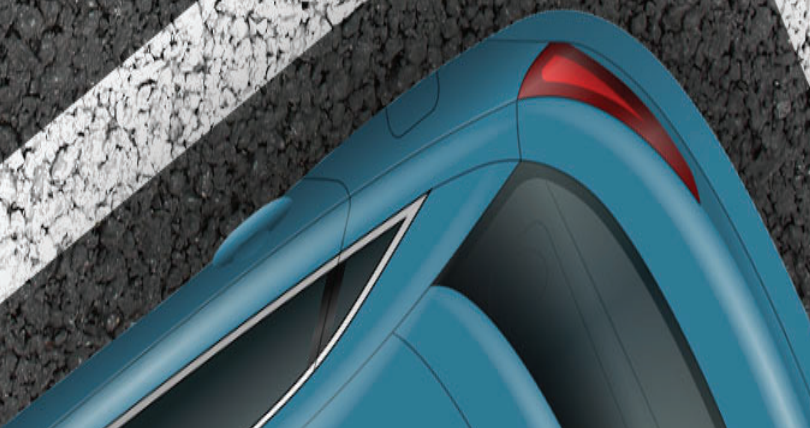

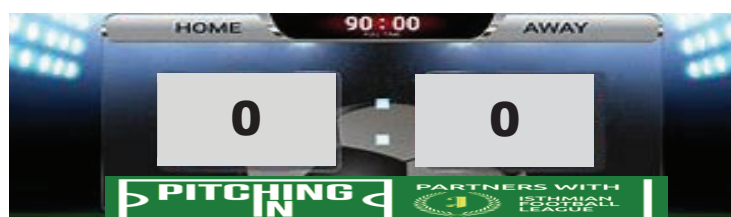

Not the best game to open the New Year by either side, but this was remarkably Bridges' first draw of the season in a match that neither side deserved to lose – or win!

Hillians looked to have more thrust in the opening stages and Lewis Finney flashed a shot wide. The first Bridges effort of note came after 25 minutes when Billy Irving's powerful shot went just the wrong side of the post. Then three minutes later a great cross from Kieron Pamment was met at the far post by Brian Villavicencio, but his header hit the inside of the post before bouncing into the grateful arms of keeper Will Huffer.

Irving shot just wide again shortly before the break, but both keepers – Huffer and Leo Anderson – could probably have put their feet up for much of that opening 45 minutes.

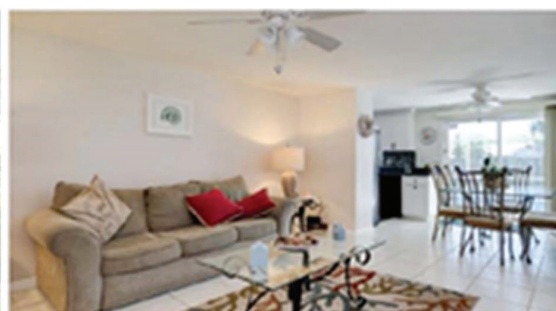
Hillians probably should have done better after 58 minutes when Martyn Box's excellent free kick found Max Miller, but his header went wide, and it wasn't until the 83rd minute that Anderson had to make his first serious save when he tipped over a decent volley by substitute Brad Santos.

Generally it was a comfortable afternoon by both defences with Irving looking particularly dominant for Bridges, but the front runners and midfield worked tirelessly without getting any rewards for their endeavours.

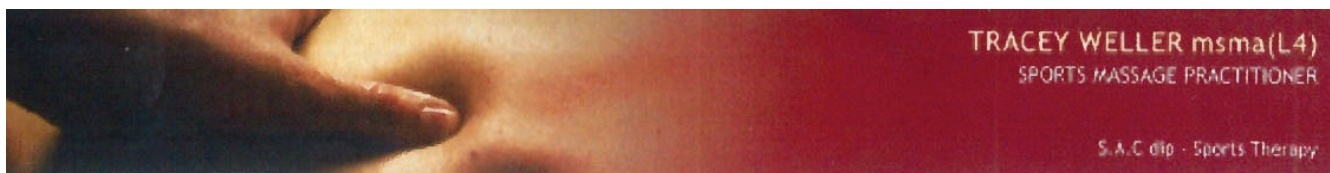

RAMSGATE FC

Ramsgate is one of the largest non-League clubs in Kent, and for the 2022/23 season are fielding 78 senior and youth teams, which includes 3 for women and 10 for girls. The club continues to grow and, following the installation of the first fixed Panna cages at an English football stadium in 2020, they replaced the pitch at Southwood with a new all-weather surface that was opened with a visit from Spurs' U23s in July 2021. The current club restarted in 1945, after the ban on football in east Kent during World War 2 was lifted, and originally called Ramsgate Athletic have played at the Southwood Stadium ever since.

Ramsgate has had senior football teams within the town since the late 1800s, and despite the paucity of newspaper coverage of football on the Channel side of the Isle of Thanet in the late 19th century there are reports of Ramsgate Athletic playing at Southwood along with the principal side, Ramsgate Town, who started about 1886 (team photos of whom exist from 1898). At this time matches were played on several pitches around the town, including the Rams' current home - Southwood. Football in east Kent closed down during the Great War and in 1919 Southwood was provided for Ramsgate Town, by then known as Ramsgate, by Henry Weigall JP and Lady Rose Weigall. In their first season they finished 3rd in the Kent FA League and reached the Kent Senior Cup final but lost to Northfleet at Maidstone 1-0 before a crowd of 10,000. In 1924 Ramsgate folded and Ramsgate Grenville moved to Southwood and, apart from the rise and fall of the more successful Dumpton-based Ramsgate (Press Wanderers) in the 1930s, Grenville became the senior Ramsgate side until another World War cancelled football.

Post-World War 2 honours have been many (see next page), especially in the late 1940s and through the 1950s, and again in the late 1960s and 1980s (and not forgetting the mid-2000s). Some say the 'golden period' was from 1954 to 1957, when former Scottish international Jimmy Blair was player/manager, and the Rams were back-to-back League Champions in 1955/56 and 1956/57, with a new attendance record being set in 1955/56 when 5,083 watched the derby against Margate. They also made Club history when they reached the 1st Round Proper of the FA for the first time in 1955, narrowly losing 5-3 at Watford (a record that stood for 50 years before they reached that round again). With the demise of the Kent FA League in 1959, the Club joined the Southern League and a new main stand was erected along the southern side of the pitch.

In 1971/72 the Club were promoted to the Southern League and changed its name to just Ramsgate, but after a decline in fortunes off the pitch the Club was relegated to Division 1 and then resigned from the League in 1976, with the 1st team taking the Reserves' place in the new Kent League. In 1998/99 the Club was eligible for promotion back to the Southern League after winning the Kent Premier League championship and the Kent FA Senior Trophy, but decided the time was not right. This was followed with more silverware in 2000/01, winning the Kent Premier Division League Cup.

The 2004/05 season saw the Rams playing (and defeating) 4 sides from higher leagues pre-season, including old rivals Margate. In competitive football they made good progress in the FA Cup, winning at Kingstonian (2 leagues higher) before falling in the 2nd half to Dulwich Hamlet (1 league higher), whilst in the FA Vase they again reached the 3rd Round Proper. The best form was saved for the domestic season where the Rams again did the double winning both the Kent League Premier Cup and League Championship by a clear margin, and after extensive ground improvements entered Ryman 1 South in 2005.

Summer 2005 saw the Rams start the new era with 2 more pieces of silverware, beating Herne Bay in the Kent League Challenge Shield and Margate in the Kent Messenger Challenge Cup. The Club reached the 1st Round Proper of the FA Cup, the only Step 4 club in the country to do so that season, equalling the Club record set 50 years earlier, but were defeated at Nuneaton. They won the League at their first attempt however, securing back-to-back promotions to the Ryman Premier Division for 2006/07. For most of their inaugural season in the Premier the Rams were settled in the 'play-off spots' and for several weeks in 2nd place, but the toll on the small squad was noticeable and they slipped to 9th place in the run-in. This meant another new record, as the Club had only managed to stay in the Southern League Premier for a single season in 1972. The 2007/08 season saw more club records being set, winning the Isthmian League Cup as well as reaching the play-offs for the Conference South. In 2008/09 an average performance on the pitch dipped in the last months with relegation back to Division 1 South. Key players left to remain at the higher level, although a much younger local side avoided a further drop in 2009/10 as some predicted.

Back in Division 1 the Rams usually finished around the play-offs until, after five managers in 14 months, they ended up in 21st place in 2013/14. This saw the return of Jim Ward for his 3rd spell in charge, and though the Rams were in 2nd place at Christmas the form dropped, and they finished mid-table. A good start in 2016/17 didn't last and with only 1 point from 3 games over Christmas coach Lloyd Blackman replaced 'Wardie' as manager. A 10-match unbeaten run saw a mid-table finish reprieve, with Blackman confirmed as gaffer for 2017/18. In 2018/19 there were several changes in chairman, and despite a good run in the FA Cup (ending at NLS Hemel Hempstead in the 3rd Qualifying Round). An 8-game unbeaten run ended, and Blackman stepped down, in November and ex-Sittingbourne boss and former Rams' captain Nick Davis took over. Indifferent results saw by ex-Herne Bay boss Jason Lillis appointed in October 2019, who in turn was replaced by Matt Longhurst in January 2020. After 2 years in charge, 4 losses in a row saw Longhurst replaced by former Gills coach Steve Lovell in April 2022 for the last 4 games. Although a turn around in form saw the Rams return to winning ways, they just failed to return to the play-off places they had been in for the first 8 months of the season, but Lovell was an ideal fit and has been retained for 2022/23.



RAMSGATE FC PLAYER PROFILES

Josh Bexon – 24-year-old Folkestone-born 'keeper who appeared for the Rams as a youth before joining Southend U18s. Spells abroad and in the UK saw him leave Southend for Harlow for the 2019/20 season before joining Dover for 2020/21. Returned to the Rams as 1st choice stopper in July 2022.

Jerald Aboagye – 30-year-old right back, Jerald signed for the Club in 2020/21 and is a powerful player who has become a fans' favourite with his energy levels. Very experienced and vital to the young players at the Club's development centre.

Jamie Coyle – 39-year-old vastly experienced defender signed from Margate in summer 2021 to aid the young squad at Ramsgate. Has played at this level and above his whole career winning numerous titles along the way. Jamie is a UEFA A Licensed coach and an FA coach educator and has proved to be a fantastic addition to the squad (and still gets the occasional goal).

Callum Emptage – 26-year-old right/centre back, Callum played previously for the Gills as a professional and was captain at East Grinstead, making over 150 appearances for the Wasps. A very competitive player with great quality, bringing vast experience to the young squad.

Ben Fitchett – 23-year-old defender who joined the Rams from Phoenix Sports last season, having played for them against the Rams in the October. Ben arrived at Phoenix from Sittingbourne having previously progressed through the ranks at Margate.

Jahmal Howlett-Mundle - 25-year-old defender who played for Hastings in the 2018/19 season before joining Sheppey United, with whom he won 4 trophies last season, and having now signed for the Rams will face his former teammates who have been promoted to Isthmian South East for 2022/23. Jahmal started out in Crystal Palace U18s, followed by spells in Scotland and then Dover, Canvey, Whitehawk and Kingstonian.

Jake McIntyre – 28-year-old centre/left back. Jake is the team captain and is a leader on and off the pitch. Having played approaching 300 games at this level he brings a wealth of experience to the group, and is a tough-tackling defender who is also very comfortable with the ball.

Jack Paxman – 25-year-old right-sided midfielder/wingback who played for Ramsgate as a youth, with his twin Alfie, before joining the Dover Academy and making a 1st team appearance in the Kent Senior Cup. The brothers returned to the Rams 1st team for 2015/16, with Jack on a dual-registration with Deal. Jack moved to Margate for 2018/19 (when Alfie moved to Folkestone) but has returned to Southwood again in summer 2022.

Daniel Haastrop – 24-year-old midfielder of Irish and Nigerian extraction, who spent time at the Maidstone and Ebbsfleet academies, playing most recently for Rusthall in the SECFL Premier, from who he has joined the Rams.

Tijan Jadama – 24-year-old midfielder. TJ progressed from the youth section and through the academy to the 1st team at Ramsgate before moving to Whitstable Town for a season. He returned to Southwood in summer 2021 where he has become a firm fans' favourite and role model for local youngsters, as well as a goal-scoring midfield player.

Denzelle Olopade – 21-year-old midfielder who signed from Crystal Palace last season. Denzelle is a 6ft 4 powerful central player who we have high hopes for. He has all the attributes to progress back into the football league if he gains valuable senior football experience and is certainly one to watch.

Lee Prescott - 35-year-old centre midfielder and one of the most experienced players in the squad, with spells playing at the higher level with Cray Wanderers and Margate. A strong, powerful midfielder who will be tasked with looking after the younger players on the pitch.

Theo Osinfolarin – 23-year-old Blackheath-born 'Theo' is a versatile player who can play at fullback, as a winger or in behind a striker. Prior to joining the Rams for 2022/23 he signed for Harlow Town in February 2022 from Brightlingsea Regent, and before that started the 2021/22 season at Cheshunt. He has also had spells with Welling, Greenwich Borough and Ashford United.

Josh Ajayi – 20-year-old centre forward who signed a two-year contract with the Club from Crystal Palace last season and possesses all the attributes to become a top player. Last season's leading goal scorer in the Isthmian South East Division until the final fortnight of the campaign, he is a fast, powerful forward who, with development in senior football, can go as far as he wants in the game.

Lauric Diakiese - 25-year-old striker who started out as a youth in Brentford, and had spells with Aldershot Town, Erith & Belvedere, Woodford Town, Harrow Borough, Ilford FC, Imortal Desportivo Clube (Portugal), Ware, Egham Town and Heybridge Swifts before joining Kettering last year, followed by a loan with Grantham before signing for Rushden & Diamonds. Started this season with Ashford Utd but joined the Rams in October.

Rowan Liburd – 30 year-old striker who joined the Rams in January from Cheshunt. 6'5" forward who scored 25 goals in his last 30 appearances before moving to Southwood, and previously had spells with Reading, Wycombe, Stevenage and Billericay.

Ashley Miller – 28-year-old forward, Ashley is a talented player who started out with the Gills' development side and went on loan with the Rams in 2012, as well as other senior Kent sides, before he was released by Gillingham and joined Maidstone in 2014. Had spells with a number of local teams, including a second with the Rams briefly in 2016/17, before returning for a third time to Southwood in 2019. At 27 Ash has flourished in this new squad of players that suit his style.



RAMSGATE FC PLAYER PROFILES

Kane Rowland – 27-year-old striker who went from the Rams' youth set up and into the 1st team with a spell at Whitstable in 2014/15 & 2015/16. Returned to the Rams in 2016, after which he became established as Sittingbourne's regular front man. Moved to Folkestone in 2018/19 but returned to Southwood in the January and stayed for 2019/20, when he was the Rams' top scorer. Kane returned to Sittingbourne for 2020/21, captaining the side last season, but is now back at Southwood after the opening games of 2022/23 (playing for the Brickies against the Rams).

MANAGEMENT

Steve Lovell – Former Welsh international and Crystal Palace striker who also has a great pedigree as a manager. As well as managing Gillingham from 2017 to 2019, and a spell as caretaker in January 2022, he has been in charge of other Kent sides including Gravesend & Northfleet (now Ebbsfleet) and Welling Utd, and opposed the Rams while in charge at Sittingbourne and Ashford. Took over at Ramsgate in April 2022 to close out 2021/22, and settled in so well has continued in charge this season.

Mark Lovell – Assistant Manager who started as a professional player at the Gills before making appearances for several Kent clubs, including Welling and Dover, but also over 70 appearances for Ramsgate where he was top scorer with 26 goals in 2010/12. Left the Rams for Tonbridge Angels and then played for Herne Bay and Faversham, hanging up his boots in 2017/18. Son of Mark Lovell and grandson of former professional footballer, Alan Lovell.

Lee Hook – 1st Team Coach and former goalkeeper and coach, who can still don the gloves if needed. Appeared in between the sticks for the Rams as a youngster in the 1990s and had trials at Wolves and Exeter as well as spells with Whitstable and Sittingbourne. He followed this with 6 seasons apiece at Eastbourne Borough and Dover, before joining Ashford for 2019/20. Expanded from playing to coaching while at Ashford and remained in that position until this season, when he returned to Southwood as 1st team coach. Son of Peter Hook, who was Ramsgate 'keeper in the 1970s, '80s, and '90s, before a season in charge in 2002/03.

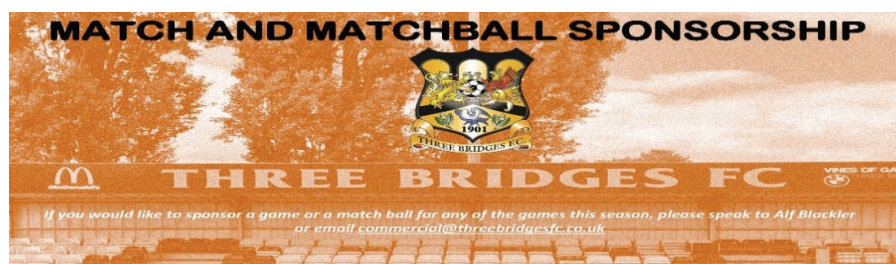
