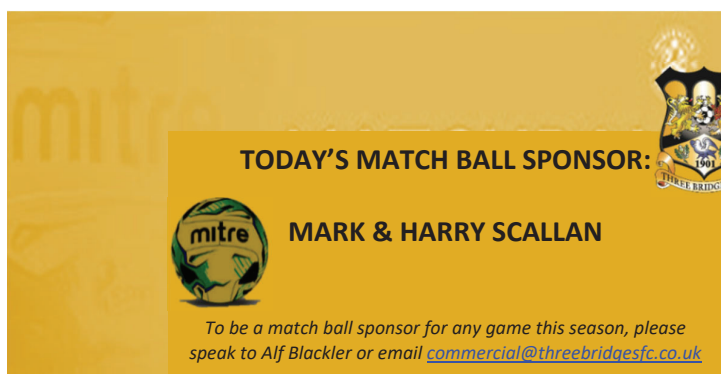

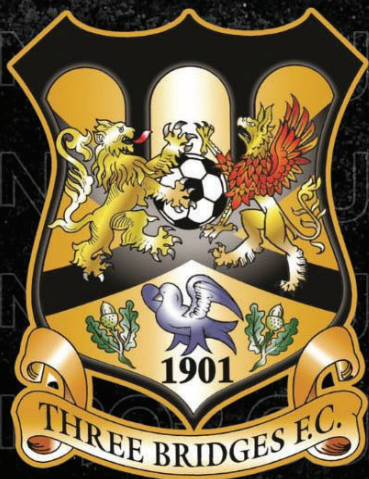

HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faii stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faii stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was a new manager for the U23s (Development Squad) with Ryan Gayler appointed as Manager and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 saw Jamie Crellin take over as First Team Manager, with Danny Lee (former Academy manager) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager. The U23s were disbanded but we had an additional U18s (all U16s) playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays but this year playing in the U17s division.

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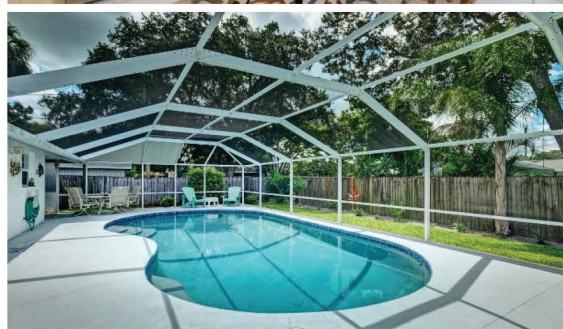

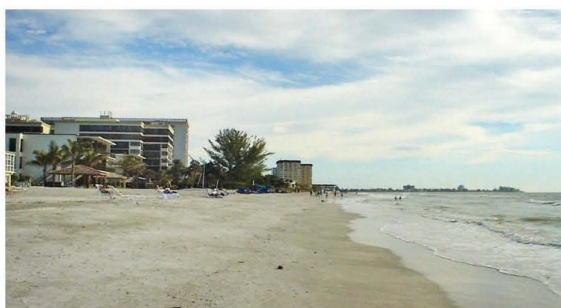
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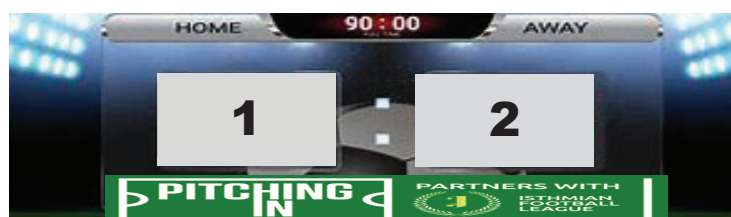

Bottom placed Corinthian, who cannot catch Bridges, are not going down without a fight, and they looked more comfortable than their hosts for long periods of the game. Their natural willingness to attack in numbers without fearing the consequences was in marked contrast to Bridges, who looked nervy and hurried at times, looking afraid to make a telling mistake.

One area that has been a downfall to Bridges for much of this season has been from corners and free kicks, and Corinthian took full advantage of this weakness after 15 minutes when **SAM FITZGERALD** headed home from Oscar Housego's well flighted corner. The visitors should have probably doubled their tally at the very least before Bridges were grateful to hear the half time whistle.

A wicked curling cross shot from Jack Beerling was turned away gratefully by Leo Anderson, but Bridges were looking better after the break and the introduction of Camron Lawson on the hour paid dividends just three minutes later. Noel Leighton powered his way through and despite being fouled managed to get the ball wide to Lawson, who drove forward and delivered the perfect low cross for **KIERON PAMMENT** to crack home the equaliser.

Anderson made a good save following neat play between the lively Oliver Box and Beerling, whilst at the other end a neat chip by Harvey Woollard was met by Kevin Rivera, but a goal line clearance denied him.

If Bridges' substitution was good, then Corinthian's added time introduction of **A. JACK BILLINGS** was absolutely inspired as only a minute after coming on he smashed the ball home from an angle on the left to claim all three points. This is another concern for Bridges, who have lost five points in three games against sides below them in the table in the last few weeks.

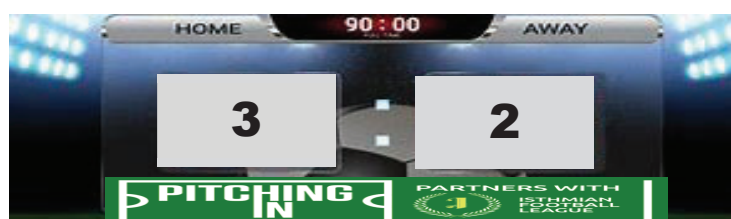

Yet another late goal denied battling Bridges a point in the brilliant Sheppey sunshine, but the performance overall was a marked improvement on recent displays by the visitors.

Kieron Pamment and Noel Leighton worked tirelessly up front for Bridges, and although neither scored, they were a constant threat and they certainly didn't deserve to finish on the losing side. Sadly, a couple of defensive slips allowed Sheppey to take control in the latter stages to boost their own play off aspirations but ensure that Bridges were still nervously looking at the pack behind them in the lower half of the table.

Leighton headed frustratingly just wide from an early Pamment cross, whilst Curtis Gayler saw a free kick blocked before the second attempt found the wrong side of the near post. Sheppey had a couple of decent chances too, but it was Bridges who went in front in first half added time. This was the third free kick effort from **CURTIS GAYLER**, whose fierce drive proved too much for keeper Aidan Prall.

The second half could not have started worse for Bridges as within 30 seconds a clumsy challenge led to a penalty. Leo Anderson did well to block Richie Hamill's spot kick, but **WARREN MFULA** was first to react to tuck home the loose ball, but just five minutes later Bridges restored their lead when Pamment's cross was driven home by **KEVIN RIVERA**.

However, a mixture of Sheppey pressure and Bridges not getting forward as enthusiastically spelt danger, although Prall was forced to make one excellent save as the ball careered off Pamment's knee!

Bryan Villavicencio should have done better when presented with a chance, but his shot was too soft, but by then a cool finish by **EDDIE ALLSOP** had given United a 62nd minute equaliser.

Leighton was just wide from another Pamment cross three minutes from time, but the ball quickly switched to the other end, where **WARREN MFULA** finished a neat move for another body blow to Jamie Crellin's side.

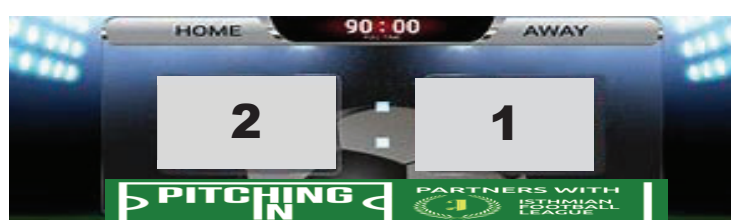

It's fast becoming a worn out record that keeps playing continually! Bridges lost yet again in the closing stages of a game that was a poor advert for the Isthmian League, taking them down to 15th place and seeing Burgess Hill now just a point behind them as they both fight to keep out of the bottom four and a potential play off!

The Hillians couldn't have dreamed of a better start as they took a 1st minute lead with a wind assisted cracker from **KIERAN ROWE** after Joe Stone's brave headed clearance fell nicely for him.

There wasn't too much action of note throughout the first half after that stunner, although Tad Bromage fired just wide and then set up Kieron Pamment for a shot that drifted past the far post. The half closed with Leo Anderson pushing away a Dan Perry cross shot and Joe Tennent seeing a header cleared following a nicely delivered free kick by Curtis Gayler.

Perry, who was Bridges top scorer last season, should have done better after being set up by substitute Max Miller, and Bridges capitalised on this when Gayler's 67th minute corner was nodded back into the area by Tad Bromage for **JOE TENNENT** to head the equaliser.

Perry was again denied by a clearance by Pamment, but a draw looked almost inevitable until a deep cross three minutes from the end of normal time wasn't gathered by Anderson, and inevitably the predatory **DAN PERRY** stabbed home to the delight of over 600 home fans.

It meant that Bridges lost three successive games to late goals in the space of seven days, and their last two games take on extra importance.

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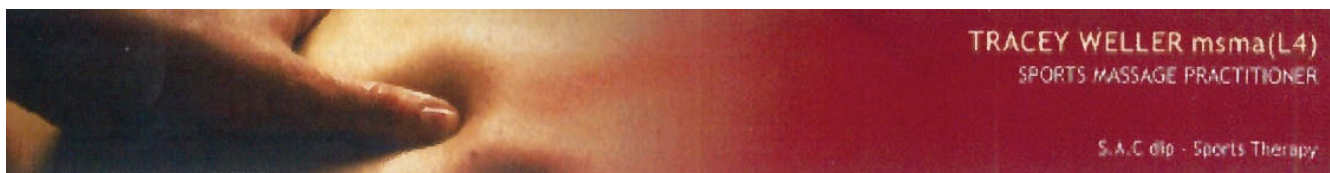

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LITTLEHAMPTON TOWN

Littlehampton Town Football Club was officially founded in 1896, but evidence suggests football was played in the town as early as 1891 and the club started in 1893. In the early years games were played at Selborne Road but in the early 1900s sport moved to The Sportsfield on St. Flora's Road where matches continue to be played today.

Back then the team's colours were dark green and the club were known as the 'Greenbacks.' The colours were changed in 1911 to blue and then in 1931 to white. In 1923 Tottenham Hotspur came to town for a friendly and won 7-1.

Littlehampton Town joined the Sussex County Football League in 1928 and the club stayed in Division 1 for 67 years. The first match in the new league was against Haywards Heath and the team won 5-1. In 1949 they won the RUR Charity Cup and the Sussex Senior Cup.

The team changed to a gold strip in 1953 and the first reference to their nickname 'The Marigolds' was in the Littlehampton Gazette on 13 November 1953. Under the guidance of Terry Gill the team were very successful in the late 1960s and they won the Sussex Senior Cup again in 1970.

Littlehampton Town were Division 1 runners-up eight times until they finally won the title in 1991. That year will never be forgotten. A draw at Peacehaven & Telscombe in front of 1,400 fans meant Golds won the title on goal difference. The same year the club won through to the First Round Proper of the FA Cup. The highlight was a home match against Northampton Town, staged at The Sportsfield in front of 4,000 fans. The Golds also reached the semi-final of the FA Vase, losing to Gresley Rovers over two legs. That year the team played more cup matches than league games and won the Sussex League Challenge Cup and reached the final of the Senior Cup.

Littlehampton Town dropped to Division Two in 1995 and Carl Stabler came back as manager and took them back up in 1997, where they were again runners-up.

In 2003 they were relegated once again, but made a swift return with a Division 2 league and cup double success. They fell out of the top flight again in 2008 and spent six years in Division 2. Mark Bennett, a former player from the 1991 season, joined as manager and oversaw the Division 2 title in 2013, where they only lost four league games all season and were finalists in the John O'Hara Cup. In 2015 they recaptured the Division 1 title - for the first time in 23 years - on the final day and the last year of the Sussex County Football League.

With Mark Bennett's departure, player George Gaskin took over management of the club and guided the team to a mid-table finish. A year later the team dropped out of the top flight and into Division 1. In 2018, Littlehampton Town welcomed back both Mark Bennett as manager and George Gaskin as striker to help rebuild the club and return them to former glories. The next two seasons were unfortunately curtailed due to the Covid-19 pandemic. In 2020, the Marigolds were unbeaten in the league, but no promotion was allowed. After a repeat performance in 2021, we did secure promotion on points-per-game.

With George Gaskin, joined at the managerial helm by Mitchell Hand, the first year back in the Southern Combination Football League Premier Division was arguably the best in the team's 126-year history to date. The Marigolds won the title, again on the final day of the season in front of 1,000 fans, but it was also in the cups that brought them so much glory. As winners of both the League Cup and the RUR Charity Cup, a historic treble was nearly a quadruple as the team reached Wembley to play in the FA Vase final.

As the first non-league team from Sussex to reach Wembley, it was an extraordinary achievement and, despite losing 3-0 in the final to Newport Pagnell Town, the amazing home crowds in the quarter and semi finals — of over 3,000 — ensured the entire town was behind the team in an incredible season. In 2022/23 they will play at Step 4 for the first time in their history as they embark on the new challenge of the Pitching In Isthmian Football League South East Division and the FA Trophy for the first time.



LITTLEHAMPTON TOWN

JAMES BINFIELD: Nicknamed 'Bins' our man between the sticks is one of the friendliest guys in the changing room. Formerly at Pagham, Binfield allows the team to play from the back or he can set up an attack.

LEWIS JENKINS: Working with his centre-half team-mate Jordan Clark, Jenkins helped make a formidable defence last season and also has been known to score a few goals too. Also a hard-working member of the squad.

JORDAN CLARK: Joined the team last year and became one of the most dependable players in the group. Captain, leader and always in control of the players around him.

DION JARVIS: Fast, direct and a goal scorer. Has played at the back and in the midfield but is at his best on the left side of the pitch terrorising defences with his pace and attacking prowess.

JORDAN LAYTON: As one of the youngest players in the team, Jordan is constantly running around the midfield, often like a pitbull. He's not afraid to put a tackle in to wrestle the ball back for his team from the opposition.

AARON CAPON: Another new signing last season and was invaluable in helping the team kick on in all the various competitions across the year. As a winger he is known as an absolute menace.

LUCAS PATTENDEN: Also one of the younger members of the squad and it's impossible not to notice this winger's pace. There is nothing less than 110 per cent commitment to going forward and he never gives up.

SHAY WIGGANS: A long-time Gold, Shay is rock solid in defence and always reliable. He gives his all and is not shy off the pitch; a big character who isn't afraid to speak his mind.

ZAC HARRIS: New to Littlehampton Town last year, the quick youngest is very popular with the rest of the team. A DJ outside of football, he's a winger and forward on the pitch and known as a silky performer.

SCOTT PACKER: After a long injury Scott returned to the squad last year following a few seasons where he played for other teams including Shoreham. He's jokingly known as the team's James Milner...

MITCHELL HAND: Has been with the team for a number of years and was arguably the best left back in the County League. Today he is joint manager of the club along with his good friend George Gaskin.

SCOTT KIRKWOOD: Joined halfway through last year and is by far the most experienced player in the squad. He came into the team and added a lot of quality to the midfield. Was unlucky to miss Wembley through suspension.

GEORGE GASKIN: A long-time Gold, George has consistently been one of our top scorers and is never under pressure in front of goal. Highly respected and now joint manager alongside Mitch Hand.

CALLUM LITTERICK: A really nice lad who is always willing to learn by speaking to the older members of the team to improve his game. A lot of older players have respected his work ethic as he's a real battler.

LIAM HENDY: Over the summer Hendy signed for the Golds having spent a decade playing for Sussex-side Lancing and most recently as captain too. He joins the squad along with his defensive partner Will Berry.

JOE BENN: Last season was one Joe Benn will never forget. He was top scorer in the league and in all competitions amassed an incredible 60 goals in a Littlehampton Town shirt, which included time out injured too.



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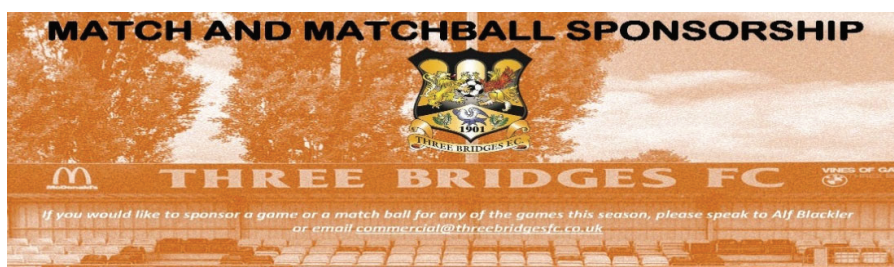

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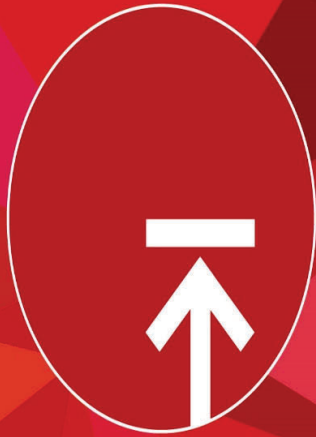
