HISTORY OF THREE BRIDGES FC

Founded in 1901, Three Bridges joined the Mid Sussex Football League in 1902 and were Champions of that League for the first time in the 1907/08 season. Their first major success came in 1933/34, when they won the Sussex Junior Cup, and sundry other minor honours came their way before they joined the Sussex County Football League in 1952/53, and two years later were crowned Second Division Champions.

In 1962/63 they won the Division Two Invitation Cup and in 1968/69, 1973/74 and 1979/80 were Second Division Runners Up. 1970/71 produced an against-the-odds triumph when winning the League's Invitation Cup against Southwick (3-2). The 1980s heralded a run of successes, starting with reaching the last 16 of the FA Vase for the first time in 1981/82 before losing at Molesey (1-2). A season later they made it to the last 32 but also won the Sussex RUR Charity Cup for the first time, beating Hastings Town 3-2. Another year on saw them finish runners up in the Thorn EMI National six-a-side tournament, winning a set of floodlights. 1985/86 saw them finish as County League Division One runners up, a feat they repeated in both 1987/88 (when they also won the RUR Cup again) and 1988/89.

A fire destroyed their clubhouse in 1993 which re-focused their priorities and ultimately resulted in relegation in 1996/97. They won the Division 2 League Cup a season later and then finished runners up in Division 2 to regain Division 1 status. They were RUR Cup runners up in 2003/04 and then winners of that same prestigious trophy in 2007/08.

In season 2010/11 hopes were high when they started by winning their first nine League games, but eventually finished the season in 5th place. However they did win the John O'Hara League Challenge Cup for the first time that season, beating Rye United 2-1, a tremendous feat that they achieved again in 2011/12, this time AFC Uckfield being defeated 2-1. It looked like being another tough League campaign when they lost four of the first nine matches, but then lost only one of the remaining 29 games, which was concluded by beating Championship rivals Rye United 1-0 at home on the final day of the season! This tremendous run meant the club had achieved its ambition and become Sussex County Football League Champions. With a superb run in the FA Vase too, losing in the last 32 on a penalty shoot-out with Derbyshire side, Gresley FC, the 2011/12 'Double' season had undoubtedly been the best in Three Bridges' history.

Their first season in the Ryman Isthmian Football League South Division saw them struggle for much of the time. However, having been 10 points adrift at the bottom of the table in mid-February, they went on a run of 11 matches that produced 7 victories, 2 draws and just 2 defeats, earning them Team of the Month Awards in both March and April as a result. It meant that they survived the drop, but their second season in the Ryman League saw them struggle at times again but some key signings midway through the season helped them to 19th place.

The 2014/15 season saw an even greater improvement with a healthy mixture of youth and experience guiding them into 7th position and, whilst they were happy to score 94 League goals, they were less than happy about the 95 they conceded! They improved their defensive record in conceding 67 goals in season 2015/16 but only scored 59, hardly helped by long-term injuries to strike partners Allan Tait and Tony Garrod. With 66 points, they slumped to 14th position, although they only accumulated 6 points fewer than in the previous campaign!

Bridges maintained most of that season's squad for the 2016/17 campaign. However, with at least 11 first team players out injured by September, they had to use a lot of the U21s, Academy and U18s players and by November had lost 12 games in a row, drew three and won just one game. Towards the end of the season, they strengthened the squad but it was too late to avoid relegation.

For the 2017/18 season, Bridges kept a few of the best of the players from the previous season and strengthened the team with more experienced players in the hope of promotion once again. Having dispensed with the services of Simon Wormull, Paul Hammond and Danny Lee from the coaching team and folding the Academy team, Bridges also strengthened the management team with the additions of the experienced ex-Bridges player, Martin Dynan as Assistant Manager, and UEFA 'A' licensed Coach, Marc Wardley.

That season turned out to be an extremely tough one with every team wanting to beat us. However, Bridges accomplished what they set out to do by gaining promotion back to the Isthmian League having finished second place in the Southern Combination League Premier Division, just one point behind the winners, Haywards Heath Town, and despite having only lost 3 games all season.

After serving 25 years with the Club as a manager, Paul Faili stood down as First Team Manager for the 2018/19 season in order to concentrate on his role as Club Chairman, and handed the management reins over to Martin Dynan, assisted by Liam Collins alongside Keith George. He also recruited a new U23s manager in Oliver Saunders, another UEFA 'A' licensed coach, to work closely with the First Team in developing both the U23s and U18s. After losing 8 out of 12 League games by the end of November, as well as being knocked out of all four cup competitions (FA Cup, FA Trophy, League Cup and Sussex Senior Cup), the future looked bleak for Martin Dynan. However, the team then went on an unbeaten run in December, earning Martin the League's Manager of the Month Award. Unfortunately, that didn't last and Martin's demise was inevitable by the end of February, having lost 8 of the last nine games with relegation looming. Paul Faili stepped in for the remaining 9 games of the season attaining 4 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses – enough for a 14th place finish and 14 points clear of relegation.

Paul remained as Manager, ably assisted by Keith George and coached by Jamie Crellin who played for the Club for five seasons, but sadly had to hang up his boots after sustaining an ankle injury early in the 2018/19 season, after making 164 appearances for the Club. Oliver Saunders remained as U23s Manager, assisted by Tom Hayward who had been involved with the U18s as both Assistant Manager and Manager over the previous four seasons, while First Team player, Brannon O'Neill, was appointed as U18s Manager. Sadly Oliver decided to move to South Park as First Team Coach in November 2019, following Martin Dynan's appointment there so Tom was appointed as U23s Manager for the remainder of the season. For the 2020/2021 season, the only change was a new manager for the U23s (Development Squad) with Ryan Gayler appointed as Manager and Tom Hayward becoming Vice Chairman.

2021/22 saw Jamie Crellin take over as First Team Manager, with Danny Lee (former Academy manager) returning to the club to join Jamie in the dugout as assistant manager. The U23s were disbanded but we had an additional U18s (all U16s) playing in the Southern Combination Football League on Sundays but this year playing in the U17s division.

This season sees Brannon O'Neill appointed as Assistant Manager following Danny Lee's departure and Joe Kay joining as First Team Coach.

The three points collected by Bridges could hardly have been more important as they strived to avoid finishing in the bottom four. But the nerves of the home supporters were showing clearly until a dramatic second goal in the 90th minute clinched the win.

Littlehampton looked the more likely scorers for much of the first half, although Noel Leighton and Kieron Pamment fired only just over. The early injury to Curtis Gayler added to the Bridges concerns too, and when a clumsy challenge by Gianni Ashley led to the referee awarding a penalty after 33 minutes, the tension was almost unbearable.

But former Bridges player Devon Fender saw his spot kick saved by Leo Anderson.

Bridges looked more composed after the break and opened the scoring two minutes after the restart. Both Pamment and Kevin Rivera did well in the attacking move before substitute CAMRON LAWSON guided the ball home.

But the second goal looked elusive. Brannon O'Neill's effort from Lawson's nice cross bounced off his knee and onto the bar, Pamment had a free kick held and another Lawson cross finished with Noel Leighton's header deflected wide.

After seventy minutes Leighton brilliantly carved out a cross for Lawson, whose first time effort crashed off the post, and suddenly the nerves seemed to be creeping in again. Lucas Pattenden was looking particularly dangerous and Dion Jarvis should have been nearer the target with an inviting header. Tad Bromage cleared off the line, but in the last minute of normal time O'Neill won possession and created the opening for PAMMENT to apply the finish and leave the home supporters happy.

With only one away win all season (and that at bottom club Corinthian), Bridges at least seemed favourites to come good at already relegated Faversham. But they chose to put in a terrible display against an ordinary side on a horrible bumpy pitch. The game had plodded along with little of note until the 18th minute when both Joe Tennent and Leo Anderson failed to clear, Tyler Christian-Law tried an overhead kick which was also casually left for SHOLA AYOOLA to gratefully stab home.

Kevin Rivera, who worked tirelessly all afternoon, saw an effort from Camron Lawson's cross saved by Bailey Vose, but after 28 minutes a free kick that seemed generous to say the least was floated in by Toby Ajala and headed home thanks to poor defending by OLLIE GRAY.

Both sides had efforts cleared off the line and Bridges seemed to have earned a penalty for what looked to be a foul on Rivera, who was incredibly cautioned for diving. Teenager Harvey Griffiths was given a runout for the visitors, but within a minute of him entering the fray, a goalmouth scramble ended with AYOOLA poaching his second of the game.

Referee Simon Finnigan was forced to leave the action with some sort of leg problem after 73 minutes, and just two minutes later failure to clear properly gave MATT PARSONS the opportunity to reward himself for a decent performance.

Harvey Woollard showed plenty of guile and determination in a rare outing in Bridges midfield, but he was one of few of his team to shine in their last match of the season.

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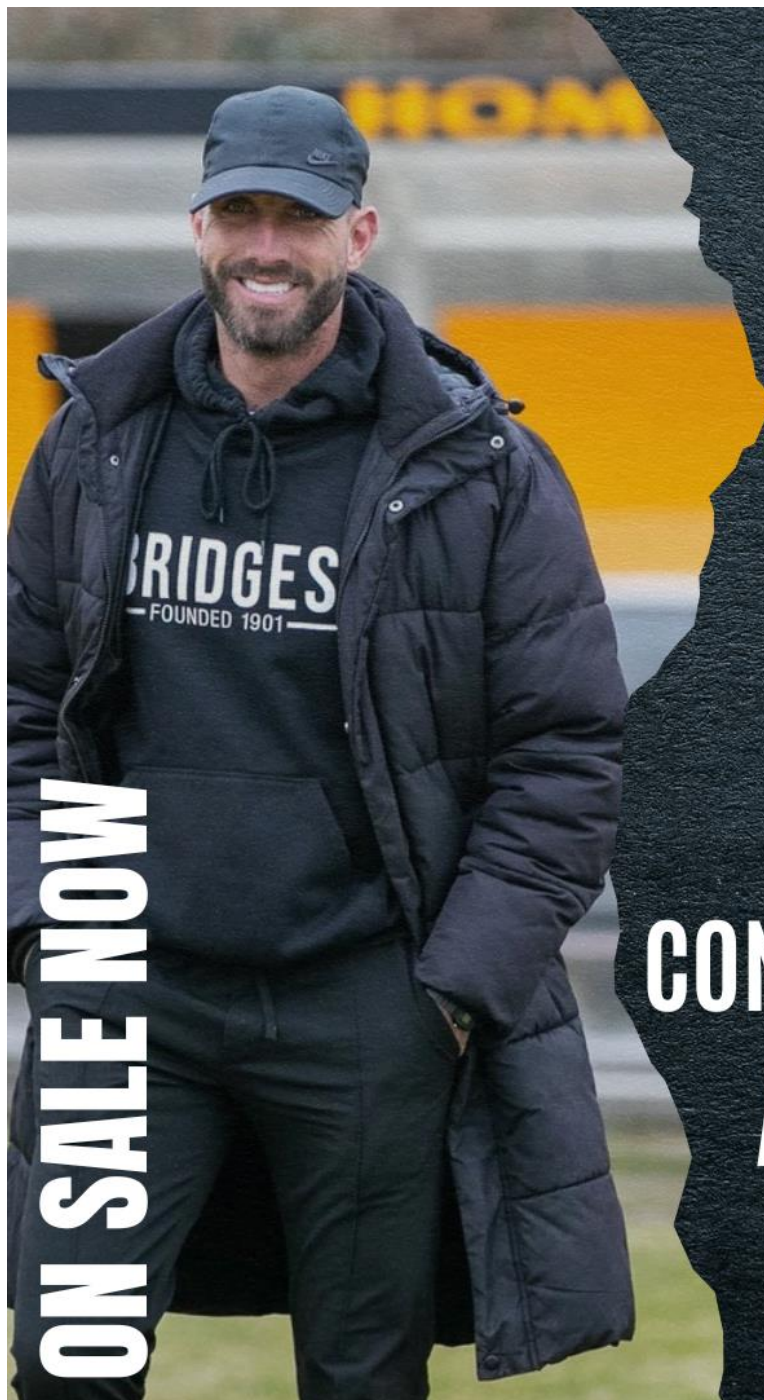

CRAWLEY DOWN GATWICK

Crawley Down Gatwick FC have made a remarkable rise from parks football to the Ryman League in less than 20 years. The club was only formed in 1993 but have enjoyed the type of success many could only hope for in their short history. In 2011 Sussex County League title success and promotion to Step 4 Football was followed by an appearance at the AMEX in the Sussex Senior Cup Final in 2012. 1983-95 Delving back into the history books to 1983, Crawley Down United could be found nestled in Division Six of the Mid Sussex League. By 1988 the club had risen to Div One, winning three league titles and finishing runnersup on two occasions. After three seasons in Div One they won promotion to the Premier Division as runners up to Lindfield. 1993/94 culminated in a merger of four local sides and adopting the name Crawley Down Village they finished third in the following season. 1994/5 they claimed their first Premier Division title by a massive margin of ten points from 2nd placed Wealden. 1995-2003 In 1995 the Anvils joined the Sussex County League Division Three. In the first season they finished second and found themselves making an even swifter move into Senior Football. They also reached the final of the Intermediate Cup. The first two seasons in Division Two provided much sought after consolidation but in the 1998-99 season they finished in a promotion position but only to be denied a place in Division One because they could not persuade Mid Sussex District Council to allow the installation of floodlights in time. The following season they thought they had finished in a promotion spot again only to be thwarted by a late decision to award Lancing three extra points after Mile Oak had fielded an illegible player. The next four seasons were not so easy for the club with changes of management and they finished no higher than 11th in that period. The 2004-07 era was better as they finished tenth and fifth and In the Division Two Cup, they reached the semifinal stage two years running. 2006-07 was a struggle only staying up after an outstanding finish to the season losing just two of the last 14 matches. Cup form: Q/F of the Sussex RUR Cup and the Div Two Cup. 2007-08 was a massive year for the club as the culmination of 10 years' hard work behind the scenes paid off with the Anvils given the go ahead to upgrade facilities. Floodlights, hard standing and stands followed and were in place for the start of the new season. The Team finished 6th and reached the semi-final of the John O'Hara League Cup. In the FA Vase they reached the 4th round losing away at Brockenhurst. The Anvils also entertained Brighton & HA in the Sussex Senior Cup. By now, the club were gaining momentum on and off the pitch and they finally won promotion to Div One with a third place finish. 2009-2010 Many expected the Division One new boys to struggle but they defied the odds to enjoy a tremendous season, finishing eighth in the league and enjoying good cup runs in the FA Cup and FA Vase as well as reaching the League Cup Final. 2010-11 Proved to be the most successful season in the club's history as the Anvils won the County League Division One and promotion to the Isthmian League by a margin of 15 points as well as winning the RUR Cup. They reached the semi-finals of both the John O'Hara and the Sussex Senior Cups where they lost to Blue Square prem side Eastbourne Borough. 2011-14 Saw the Club compete in the Isthmian South for the first time and the Club set about building a team to compete at this level, finishing in 15th place and also getting to the Sussex Senior Cup Final at the AMEX, losing out in the last minute to Ryman South Champions Whitehawk. A name change to Crawley Down Gatwick FC was approved highlighting the wider area to which the Club is now associated. 2012/13 Season started remarkably well with the team topping the Ryman South table through to November but finally finishing in 13th position. Forced Manager changes meant a massive dip in form in 2013/14, which saw the Anvils end up second to bottom and relegation. 2014/15 The Club rejoined the Sussex County League, unfortunately a 2nd relegation followed to the newly named Southern Combination League Div 1. 2015/16 saw the revival of the side under Paul Cooper as the rebuilt Anvils challenged at the top all season, finally finishing in 2nd place to Haywards Hth Town and 14 points clear of 3rd placed Oakwood to gain promotion back to the Southern Combination Premier Division. 2017-23 Back in the SCL Prem the side continued its improvement finishing in a midtable position and reaching the RUR Cup Final in that first year. The following season they achieved a midtable finish and a Peter Bentley Cup semi final.

CRAWLEY DOWN GATWICK

James Day took over the side from 2018-19 and did well in his first season as the side finished in 9th place with 57 points. 2019/21 Covid dominated and the League was abandoned with CDG in 6th Pos. 21-22 the team again ended mid table and a run to R3 of the FA Vase. 22/23 Proved to be a very good season with The Anvils finishing in 2nd place behind Broadbridge Heath and losing out on promotion to Isthmian side Sutton Common Rovers in a promotion play off.

They started their 2023/24 campaign last Saturday (29th July) and came away with a single goal victory at Pagham. The other results in the Southern Combination Premier League that day were

The winners of this tie will be at home to Hanworth Villa in the Preliminary Round on Saturday 19th August.
